

Beas River Equestrian Centre – Visitor Safety Guidelines

For your safety and enjoyment, please pay attention and adhere to the following guidelines when visiting Beas River Equestrian Centre (BREC):

• Do:

- ✓ Visit BREC during opening times: 8am 12noon, 2pm -6pm
- ✓ Understand that horses have a strong flight instinct, and therefore want to run away from anything that scares them. Remain quiet and calm at all times. If you are pushing a baby pram, please stop if you see a horse walking nearby, and let them walk past before continuing





- ✓ Enjoy observing horse's behavior and body language from a distance
- ✓ Keep children quiet, calm and, if under 16 years, under supervision at all times
- ✓ Keep your group together, and pass left hand to left hand when passing a ridden or led horse
- ✓ Wear suitable footwear; not open toed sandals
- ✓ Keep dogs on leads, and under control
- ✓ Drive vehicles slowly when on surrounding roads and entering BREC
- ✓ Give way to horses at all times





- ✓ Report any accident to a BREC staff member or the admin office immediately
- ✓ Book a 'stable tour' for an informative 30 minutes tour of our facilities, horses and ponies

• Don't:

- X Make sudden noises or movements which may startle the horses. Do not ride scooters, bikes or run in the vicinity of the stables or arenas
- X Cross the boundary hedge in front of the stables to touch the horses or to take photos with the horse. It is there for your protection, and the welfare of the horses





- X Smoke near the stables and paddocks
- X Feed horses in the stables
- X Enter a stable without authorisation
- X Enter a paddock without authorization
- X Bring dogs into any stable block
