All athletes taking part in this CSI1* Grand Prix must attend the horse inspection and technical meeting scheduled on 27 April, 2018 (Friday) afternoon. All Athletes taking part in a Grand Prix at a CSI must have completed, with their Grand Prix Horse, the training session scheduled on 27 April, 2018 (Friday) after the horse inspection and technical meeting.

If an Athlete/Horse combination has completed the initial round of an FEI Competition prior to the Grand Prix, and the Athlete is subsequently eliminated or disqualified from the Competition in question, the Athlete may take part in the Grand Prix (if qualified), with the same Horse, as the Horse is deemed to have fulfilled the eligibility requirement of completing the initial round of an FEI Competition prior to the Grand Prix. Other details can be referred to the FEI approved schedule for the CSI1* Hong Kong on 28 April, 2018.
