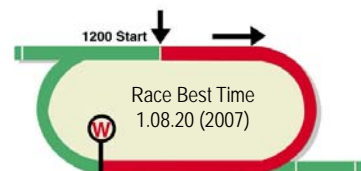


# Chairman's Sprint Prize (Group 1)

The lead-up races to the Chairman's Sprint Prize have been spoiled to some extent by Peniaphobia leading initially and then putting on the brakes, slowing the race down to a relative crawl. The arrival of some international visitors might change that and connections of most runners will appreciate a more genuine tempo here. Historically, leading is an advantage at the ST 1200m circuit but that didn't stop the amazing Aussie visitor, Chautauqua, coming from tailed-off with a thundering finish to score in 2016.
