FWD Champions Day 2019 will see some of the world's best gallopers race for HK\$58 million in what promises to be another elite day of thoroughbred action at Sha Tin on Sunday, 28th April.

The 2019 edition of Champions Day will be the second running of Hong Kong's spring feature race day under its current format, which includes 3 International Group 1 contests in the HK\$16M Chairman's Sprint Prize (1200m), HK\$18M FWD Champions Mile (1600m) and the HK\$24M FWD QEII Cup (2000m).

This year the Hong Kong Jockey Club is pleased to partner with FWD Insurance for the first time as the principal sponsor of this global racing event.

Participation in the afternoon's three Group 1 contests will include no less than 16 Group 1 winners hailing from Hong Kong, Japan, Great Britain, Australia and New Zealand.

Amongst the elite racehorses to grace the Sha Tin turf are the current equal leader of the 2019 LONGINES World's Best Racehorse Rankings in Hong Kong's very own Beauty Generation, as well as the current world's joint highest rated sprinter in Santa Ana Lane from Australia.

Race one will commence at 12:45 p.m. with the first of the Group 1 races, the Chairman's Sprint Prize, set for 3:20 p.m.

Trivia

1

Ivictory in 2018 joined Silent Witness (2004) and Sacred Kingdom (2008) as the third four-year-old winner of this race since the turn of the century.

2

Ivictory matched Tajasur (2000) in taking this event at their first start in a G1/HKG1 race. They both won a handicap immediately before their Chairman's Sprint Prize success.

3

Ever Win in 1979 and Ivictory last year are the only horses to have won this race from Gate 7.

4

John Size became the second trainer to complete a one-two-three finish in this race with Ivictory, Mr Stunning and Beat The Clock last year. Ivan Allan was the first to achieve the feat with Fairy King Prawn, Cliffhanger and Plenty-Plenty in the 2001 renewal.

5

The race was ranked equal 34th in the 2018 World's Top 100 G1 Races.

6

Australian sprinter Chautauqua created history when he became the first overseas horse to win this race in 2016, the first time the race was opened to international competition.

7

Quicken Away is the only horse to have won the Chairman's Sprint Prize three times (1989, 1990 & 1991). Seven others since 1985 have won the race twice, the latest being Lucky Nine in 2013 & 2014.

8

Fairy King Prawn's success in 1999 is the last time a three-year-old won the Chairman's Sprint Prize.

9

Legendary sprinter Silent Witness extended his unbeaten streak to 16 when he won his second Chairman's Sprint Prize in 2005. That victory also equalled the world record for the modern era of career runs unbeaten.

10

Silent Witness is the shortest priced winner (1/20 in 2005), while Dim Sum is the longest-priced winner in the past 34 editions, having won the 2009 renewal at 50/1.

11

Top favourites have won 16 of the past 34 runnings of the Chairman's Sprint Prize, including 11 that started even-money or shorter.


Basil Marcus is the most successful jockey in the race's history, having won five times. His first win aboard Concert King in 1992 denied Quicken Away what would have been an incredible fourth win in the race.

13

While Ivan Allan is the all-time most successful Chairman's Sprint Prize trainer with six wins, John Moore is the most successful active trainer, having notched four wins and 17 placings from 60 runners since 1986. He is followed by Ricky Yiu, the most successful home-grown trainer in this race with three wins.

14

Tony Cruz rode Ever Win to victory in the inaugural version of this race in April 1979. He has notched four more victories in this race, two as a jockey and two as a trainer – most recently with Silent Witness in 2005.



This will be slightly strange --- an international sprint race without an obvious leader. None of the invitees are at their best when left in front so it's hard to see the pace being too strong. Top-level sprints at Sha Tin are typically won by the horses racing prominently, with the notable exception of Chautauqua, who came from a distant last when he rounded up Lucky Bubbles to win the 2016 Chairman's Sprint Prize in the final bound. Given the lack of obvious speed this year, the ideal position should be up close with cover.

Spotlight

Hong Kong's sprinters face tough raiders in what promises to be the season's most thrilling speed race.

Australia won the first international G1 edition of the Chairman's Sprint Prize with the late-thrusting grey Chautauqua. Santa Ana Lane is another real deal Australian sprint star heading to Sha Tin. The latest of the six-year-old's five G1 wins was achieved last time out, an impressive score in the T. J. Smith Stakes (1200m).

Viddora, meanwhile, heads to Hong Kong from Australia via a good fourth in Dubai's G1 Al Quoz Sprint (1200m) - the six-year-old mare is a two-time G1 winner.

Mr Stunning and Beat The Clock - second and third in this race last year - have been at the top of Hong Kong's sprint division this term. Mr Stunning landed a second G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint (1200m) in December, while Beat The Clock took the G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (1200m) a month later.

That speedy duo received a shock - albeit when carrying 5lb G1 penalties - when Rattan rattled past them to win the prime lead-up to this contest, the G2 Sprint Cup (1200m).

New Zealand will cheer on Enzo's Lad, who in January nailed back-to-back wins in the G1 Telegraph (1200m).

Japan's Nac Venus is set to take her place in the 10-runner line-up. The G1-placed galloper won the G3 Keeneland Cup in August.

Race History

Sha Tin Racecourse opened its doors in October, 1978, and in line with that new era for Hong Kong racing an elite 1200m contest was inaugurated. That first edition on 29 April, 1979 was titled the Hong Kong Sprint Championship but a more familiar moniker, the Chairman's Prize, was introduced a year later. The Arthur Ward-trained Ever Win took the first running under Tony Cruz.

By 1989, when Quicken Away won the first of three consecutive renewals, the race was a million-dollar affair: that year's contest was worth HK\$1.032 million, with only the Hong Kong Invitation Cup and Hong Kong Derby holding higher purses. Three years later, it attained HKG1 status and in the 1993/94 season, when the Champion Sprint Series was established, the Chairman's Prize took its natural place as one of the three legs.

It was in 2001 that the race title became the Chairman's Sprint Prize and the purse that year was HK\$4.5 million. In 2007 the race shifted to February from a March/April slot in the calendar, thus becoming the second leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series. The 2016 edition was the first time it was run as an international G1 contest, with prize money upped to HK\$10 million. The race was shifted to an April/May date - as the final leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series and the fourth leg of the Global Sprint Challenge - to fill the void left by Singapore's discontinued KrisFlyer International Sprint.

The Chairman's Sprint Prize was ranked equal 34th in the World's Top 100 G1 Races in 2018. Its prize money was increased to the current level of HK\$16 million ahead of that year's contest.

Notable winners of the Chairman's Sprint Prize include world champion sprinters Silent Witness (2004 & 2005) and Sacred Kingdom (2008 & 2010), as well as Fairy King Prawn (1999 & 2001), Joy And Fun (2012) and Lucky Nine (2013 & 2014). In 2016, Australian sensation Chautauqua became the first internationally-trained winner of the race. Local runners Lucky Bubbles and Ivictory took the spoils in 2017 and 2018.

Last year's winner Beauty Generation is the fourth horse, following Good Ba Ba in 2007/08, Able Friend in 2014/15 and Maurice in 2015/16, to complete the Hong Kong Mile-Champions Mile double in the same season.

2

Beauty Generation gave trainer John Moore a record seventh win in the race and his sixth since 2010.

3

The 2018 winner Beauty Generation, at 1.9, is among the five shortest odds favourites to have won the Champions Mile. But Able Friend, sent off at odds of 1.2 in 2015, is the shortest-priced winner in the race's history.

4

The race was ranked equal 29th in the World's Top 100 Group 1 Races in 2018.

5

The FWD Champions Mile purse now stands at HK\$18 million, almost four times more than the HK\$4.6 million on offer in its inaugural running in 2001.

6

Brett Prebble's third Champions Mile win came aboard Contentment in 2017, making him the race's most successful jockey. He is followed by Joao Moreira, Weichong Marwing and Darren Beadman at two wins apiece.

7

Some 32 overseas horses from eight countries (Australia, France, UK, Japan, Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa and UAE) have contested the race since it was opened to international runners in 2005.

8

2016 winner Maurice is one of only three overseas horses to have won three races in Hong Kong (France's Jim And Tonic and Japan's Eishin Preston are the others). His Champions Mile victory came five months after his success in the 2015 Hong Kong Mile and he completed the trio when taking the Hong Kong Cup later in 2016.

9

Maurice (2016) and Variety Club (2014) are the only two overseas winners of the FWD Champions Mile. Variety Club won by four lengths, the largest winning margin in the race's history.



Hong Kong's champion racehorse and reigning Horse of the Year BEAUTY GENERATION has made front-running his signature tune. He may not necessarily run quick fractions early but he increases the tempo mid-race and puts rivals under pressure before they're ready. On face value, none of his fellow HK-based invitees can go with him and given the make-up of the field it's hard to see the race being run any different to expectation. In "normal" feature mile races at Sha Tin, the sweet spot has been behind midfield and away from the rail, but in the BEAUTY GENERATION era, those horses are barely competitive.

Spotlight

Beauty Generation is among the world's very best racehorses and the "Master Miler" will attempt a second G1 FWD Champions Mile success against six rivals. Trainer John Moore's six-year-old is unbeaten in his last eight races, seven of which have been this season, matching the Hong Kong all-time record for most wins in a campaign. Victory would see him surpass Viva Pataca as the highest earner in Hong Kong history.

The field also features high-class milers Conte and Rise High and the 2018 Hong Kong Classic Cup victor Singapore Sling.



Race History

The FWD Champions Mile is the only one of Hong Kong's 12 Group 1 contests to have been established after the turn of the millennium. That first edition came in 2001 and carried a purse of HK\$4.6 million. The race was established initially as a HKG1 contest, designed as a finale for Hong Kong's star milers, and it was the Brian Kan-trained Red Pepper that scored under Eric Legrix.

International runners were first welcomed in 2005 when the prize money rose to HK\$8 million. In a classic clash of the titans, Bullish Luck edged his great stablemate Silent Witness. That result ended the latter's unbeaten streak that had stretched through 17 races. Bullish Luck became the first two-time winner when he followed-up in 2006.

The Champions Mile attained international G1 status in 2007 and Able One took the spoils. The John Moore-trained galloper triumphed again in 2010, by which time the race was worth HK\$12 million (increased in 2009). Moore rattled off an unbroken streak of four wins as Xtension took the next two renewals for the trainer and Dan Excel battled to victory in 2013. Moore is the race's most successful trainer with seven wins: The great champion Able Friend took the race in 2015 and another Horse of the Year, Beauty Generation, ensured a seventh Champions Mile success in 2018, when the total prize money increased to HK\$18 million.

South Africa's Variety Club, trained by Mike de Kock, became the first overseas raider to win the FWD Champions Mile in 2014, defeating hot favourite Able Friend. Japanese galloper Maurice joined that list in 2016 when the Champions Mile formed the middle leg of a stellar treble in Hong Kong that included wins in the 2015 Hong Kong Mile (1600m) and the 2016 Hong Kong Cup (2000m). Other notable winners down the years include Good Ba Ba (2008) and Electronic Unicorn (2003).

Insurance brand FWD is the title sponsor of Champions Mile this year. The premier mile event was ranked equal 29th in the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities (IFHA) World's Top 100 G1 Races in 2018.

Won first up this season over 1400m by 0.75L at Class 1 level but unplaced next three starts. Smart effort when 1.75L 3rd at G3 level behind Exultant in the Centenary Vase (1800m) and then failed to claim a third consecutive MAC G1 Macau Hong Kong Trophy when 0.5L 2nd to Horse Of Fortune. Disappointing over 2000m latest. Generally settles on the speed but versatile. Has won on good and yielding ground.

Trivia

Pakistan Star in 2018 became the second German-bred horse to win the FWD QEII Cup, following Silvano in 2001.

2

Owner Kerm Din's Pakistan Star is the only Hong Kong International Sale graduate to have won the QEII Cup.

3

Pakistan Star and Gold Mount completed a stable one-two for trainer Tony Cruz, only the second time that has been achieved since 1995. Designs On Rome and Military Attack quinellaed for trainer John Moore in the 2014 renewal.

4

French runner Jim And Tonic holds the race record time, having won the 1999 renewal in 2m 00.1s, which stood as the 2000m track record at Sha Tin for 19 years.

5

Japan is the overseas jurisdiction with the most FWD QEII Cup wins. Neorealism brought his nation a fourth win in this race in 2017. South Africa has three successes.

6

With Neorealism's QEII Cup victory, Japanese trainer Noriyuki Hori became the first overseas trainer to win five Group 1s in Hong Kong.

7

Four horses – Werther (2016), Designs On Rome (2014), Ambitious Dragon (2011) and Vengeance Of Rain (2005) - have completed the QEII Cup and Hong Kong Derby double in the same year.

8

With five wins, John Moore is the most successful QEII Cup trainer in the past 30 years (2016 Werther, 2014 Designs On Rome, 2013 Military Attack, 2007 & 2010 Viva Pataca).

9

With three wins apiece, Douglas Whyte (2011 Ambitious Dragon, 1998 Oriental Express, 1997 London News) and Mick Kinane (2007 Viva Pataca, 1995 Red Bishop, 1994 Deerfield) are the winning-most jockeys in recent QEII Cup history.

10

Only three favourites have won the FWD QEII Cup since it became a 2000m race in 1997 - Designs On Rome in 2014, Ambitious Dragon in 2011 and Eishin Preston in 2003.

11

Werther's winning margin of four and a half lengths in 2016 was the second largest in the race's history. Quicken Away scored a sensational seven-length triumph in 1990.

12

Hong Kong's Viva Pataca (2007 & 2010) and Japanese raider Eishin Preston (2002 & 2003) are the only two horses to have won the QEII Cup twice.

13

South African raider Iridescence, successful in 2006, is the only filly or mare to have won the QEII Cup.

14

The FWD QEII Cup carries a total purse of HK\$24 million in 2019 and is currently the third-richest race in Hong Kong, after the HK\$28 million Hong Kong Cup and HK\$25 million Hong Kong Mile.



There looks to be speed aplenty in the 2019 renewal of the QEII Cup. The major question will be which horses persist for front-running honours and which steady behind the speed. There is also the possibility of a speed duel, but however it plays out the tempo should be strong enough. The barrier draw is hugely important at the Sha Tin 2000m start, which is effected right in front of the grandstand, shortly before the winning post. The short run to the first turn is especially tough on horses with a forward running style which have drawn wide. On the flip side, midfield runners who draw wide will often find themselves two or three positions further back than they might prefer.

Spotlight

Japan has won the FWD QEII Cup four times thanks to Eishin Preston (2002 & 2003), Rulership (2012) and Neorealism (2017). This time around, Lys Gracieux and Deirdre will lead the Japanese assault, bringing their top-class ability back to Hong Kong to build on their fine efforts at the LONGINES Hong Kong International Races in December.

Four months ago, at Sha Tin, Deirdre placed second in the G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Cup (2000m), while Lys Gracieux was second to Exultant in the G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Vase (2400m). Deirdre was a solid fourth to superstar filly Almond Eye in the G1 Dubai Turf last time, while Lys Gracieux warmed up for her FWD QEII Cup test with a good second in the G2 Kinko Sho (2000m).

Japan will also send across Win Bright who is rolling off two good wins, latterly in the G2 Nakayama Kinen (1800m) which he also won in 2018.

Race History

In 1975 the British monarch Queen Elizabeth II arrived in Hong Kong for a state visit. To mark the event, on 5 May, the Hong Kong Jockey Club staged the inaugural running of the Queen Elizabeth II Cup, with a prize fund of HK\$50,000. Her Majesty was in attendance at Happy Valley and presented the winning trophy to Mr. and Mrs. Barma, whose horse Nazakat had prevailed in the 1575m sand track handicap under Malaysian rider A. K. Cheam for trainer Cheung Hok Man.

The race continued as a handicap for 17 years, its distance switching between 1400m, a mile, 1800m, and once at 2000m in April 1986. The race, which moved to Sha Tin in 1979, was in fact staged twice in 1986, first in April and then in October when the Queen was once again in attendance, that time to see Forever Gold win a 1600m renewal.

In April 1992 the contest was raised to HKG2 level and River Verdon won that mile edition. Three years later the race was opened up to international competition, as a local G1 contest. The UAE trainer Hilal Ibrahim sent Red Bishop to carry off the then 2200m race under Mick Kinane. That win presaged the following year's victory of Overbury for the newly-formed Godolphin as trainer Saeed bin Suroor and jockey Frankie Dettori teamed up to clinch an early international conquest for Sheikh Mohammed's operation. In 1997 the QEII Cup's distance of 2000m was firmly established and a young Douglas Whyte partnered South Africa's London News to success. The first Hong Kong victory of the international era came one year later when Oriental Express triumphed.

The race attained international G2 status in 1999, before it became Hong Kong's fourth international G1 race in 2001, the year in which the German raider Silvano took the winner's share of the HK\$10 million purse under Andreas Suborics. That purse money leapt to HK\$14 million in 2002 when the race was included in the now defunct World Racing Championships series.

Hong Kong runners have won seven of the past 10 editions of the QEII Cup, including last year's winner Pakistan Star. Four of those home winners have claimed that same season's Horse of the Year title (2011 Ambitious Dragon; 2013 Military Attack; 2014 Designs On Rome; 2016 Werther).

Insurance brand FWD is the title sponsor of the QEII Cup this year. The race now carries total prize money of HK\$24 million, making it the third-richest race in the local racing calendar.

**Cruz, Tony***FWDQEII – Exultant, Time Warp; CM – Romantic Touch; CSP – Winner's Way*

Age: 62. Tony Cruz is a son of Johnny Cruz, a renowned rider from Hong Kong's amateur era. His brother, Derek, was also a trainer. He was among the first intake of apprentices to the HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School in 1972. Cruz started his riding career in the 1973/74 season, went on to be Hong Kong's champion jockey six times and rode 946 winners. Cruz also made his name at G1 level in Europe and partnered the great race mare Triptych. He started training in 1996 and won the trainers' title in 1999/2000 and 2004/2005, latterly setting a then record for a season's winners (91) and earnings (HK\$113m). He trained the great Hong Kong champion Silent Witness to win 17 consecutive races. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Jockey (1978/79, 1980/81, 1982/83, 1983/84, 1985/86, 1994/95); Hong Kong Champion Trainer (1999/00, 2004/05). **FWD Champions Day race wins (6):** FWD Champions Mile (2005 & 2006 Bullish Luck), FWD QEII Cup (2015 Blazing Speed, 2018 Pakistan Star), Chairman's Sprint Prize (2004 & 2005 Silent Witness). **Hong Kong wins: 1,217.**

**Fownes, Caspar***FWDQEII – Southern Legend; CM – Rise High*

Age: 51. Caspar Fownes assisted his late father Lawrie for several seasons before gaining his licence in 2003/04. He eclipsed his father's best season stats in his rookie year with 44 wins. In 2006/07 he won his first premiership and has since added two more. His third championship came in 2013/14 when his strong late charge brought three wins on the closing day to tie with John Size on 62 wins, and with one more second place than his rival he sealed the title on count-back. Fownes is particularly known for his fine record at Happy Valley where he has notched more than 440 career wins, a tally second only to Hong Kong's longest-serving trainer John Moore. His big race wins offshore include Lucky Nine's double in the KrisFlyer International Sprint (2013 and 2014) and Southern Legend's score in the 2018 Kranji Mile. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Trainer (2006/07, 2008/09, 2013/14). **FWD Champions Day race wins (2):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2013 & 2014 Lucky Nine). **Hong Kong wins: 822.**

**Freedman, Anthony***CSP – Santa Ana Lane*

Age: 55. Anthony Freedman is the third eldest of racing's famous Freedman Brothers (Lee, Michael, Anthony and Richard), who together until 2008, combined to win an astonishing 124 G1's, including two Melbourne Cups, four Caulfield Cups, four consecutive Golden Slippers and two Cox Plates. Anthony completed year 12 at Canberra Grammar and began working with his brothers Lee and Richard at their Warwick Farm stable in 1983. He played an integral part in Freedman Racing's move to Flemington in 1984, until Sydney called again and he was tasked with heading up their Randwick stable in 1992. He prepared Bint Marscay to win the 1993 Golden Slipper Stakes at Rosehill, the first of four consecutive Slippers the brothers would win. Anthony is well known for selecting Mummify as a yearling, who the brothers trained to win five G1's including the 2003 Caulfield Cup and the 2005 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji. Anthony has been head trainer of his own operation since the beginning of the 2011/12 season and he trained his first G1 in his own name when Mawingo won the Doomben Cup on 19 May, 2012, since then he has added a further 12 to his tally. **Hong Kong wins:** No previous Hong Kong runners.

**Gibson, Richard***CSP – Rattan*

Age: 49. Englishman Richard Gibson established himself as a Group 1 trainer in France before he arrived in Hong Kong for the 2011/12 season. He gained a solid grounding in the art and science of training racehorses with Frenchmen Pascal Bary and Henri-Alex Pantall, as well as Americans Bill Mott and Gary Jones. He took out his licence at Chantilly in 1996 and struck gold as early as 1999 when Lady Of Chad won the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac en route to becoming European Champion Juvenile Filly. He has trained the winners of eight G1s altogether, the highlights being Akeed Mofeed's and Doctor Dino's exploits in Hong Kong and the USA, and Gold-Fun's big race triumphs at Sha Tin. **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2015 Gold-Fun). **Hong Kong wins: 216.**

**Hall, David***CSP – Little Giant*

Age: 55. David Hall was born in Adelaide, the son of trainer Joe Hall. He began training at Morphettville in 1988 and moved to Melbourne five years later. Best known at home for winning the Melbourne Cup in 2003 with the brilliant Makybe Diva, he also trained Silent Witness before the champion sprinter switched to Hong Kong. Hall began his training career in Hong Kong in 2004/05. Absolute Champion's victory in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint is his Hong Kong highlight to date. **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2007 Absolute Champion). **Hong Kong wins: 432.**

**Hashida, Mitsuru****FWDQEII – Deirdre**

Age: 66. Son of a former jockey and trainer, Hashida has plied his trade since 1985 and is currently the President of the Japan Trainers Association. Passing Shot brought him his first G1 success in the Mile Championship in 1990, and he has collected no less than 11 G1 wins over the years. His leading performers include HKIR runners Silence Suzuka (1998 Takarazuka Kinen), Admire Cozzene (1998 Yasuda Kinen), Admire Max (2005 Takamatsunomiya Kinen), as well as Admire Vega (1999 Tokyo Yushun), Admire Groove (2003 & 2004 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup), and his current flagbearer Deirdre (2017 Shuka Sho). He has amassed a total of 697 JRA wins in his career, including five of them this year.

Hong Kong wins: 0**Hatakeyama, Yoshihiro****FWDQEII – Win Bright**

Age: 56. Hatakeyama commenced his JRA career as a work rider in 1986, before obtaining his JRA training licence in 1999 and started his stable operation the following year. Meiner Dupre's success in the G3 Kyodo News Service Hai in 2004 was Hatakeyama's first at Group level. His top-class breakthrough and his sole G1 win to date came from Meiner Ho O's victory in the 2013 NHK Mile Cup. His other top performers include three-time G2 winner Win Bright, and top dirt fillies Grab Your Heart and Trois Bonheur, who brought the trainer a total of nine Group wins on the regional NAR circuit. He has amassed a total of 298 JRA wins, including six this season. **Hong Kong wins:** No previous Hong Kong runners.


**Kennewell, Lloyd****CSP – Viddora**

Age: 37. Lloyd Kennewell grew up around horses at his father Gary's stables and following the completion of a Business Management Course, decided to set up on his own in 2003 and applied for his training licence. Kennewell made history upon receiving his licence, becoming the youngest recipient in South Australia at just 21 years of age. His first winner was Treasure Time who won at the now closed, Cheltenham Park Racecourse in Adelaide on 14 February, 2004. He won his first G1 when Viddora took out the 2017 Winterbottom Stakes at Ascot in Perth. Kennewell trained Viddora to her second G1 win in the 2018 Moir Stakes at Moonee Valley. **Hong Kong wins:** No previous Hong Kong runners.


**Lor, Frankie F C**

FWDQEII – Dark Dream, Furore, Glorious Forever; CM – Simply Brilliant; CSP – Mr Stunning

Age: 53. Frankie Lor began his career as a jockey in Hong Kong, notching 27 wins between 1981 and 1995. He then became a work rider before working as an assistant to a number of trainers, most notably to two of Hong Kong's greats, John Moore and John Size. Lor was granted a licence ahead of the 2017/18 Hong Kong racing season. His first win was achieved with his first runner, Yourthewonforme, in a Class 4 contest at the season opener on 3 September, 2017. Lor ended the campaign second in the premiership behind his old master John Size. His final tally of 65 wins surpassed Hong Kong's previous best first-season total, set by Size when winning his first Hong Kong trainers' championship in 2002. This term he has enjoyed G1 victories with Mr Stunning (Hong Kong Sprint) and Glorious Forever (Hong Kong Cup) and took all three legs of the 4YO Classic Series with Furore (BMW Hong Kong Derby & Hong Kong Classic Mile) and Mission Tycoon (Hong Kong Classic Cup). **Hong Kong wins:** 113.

**Millard, Tony****CM – Singapore Sling**

Age: 57. Tony Millard's father was the legendary multiple South African champion trainer Terrance Millard. He made an impressive start to his own training career in 1991. He was champion trainer in South Africa twice and won all of that country's majors. He trained three Horses of the Year there in Empress Club, Jet Master and Surfing Home as well as numerous other champions. He sent out 39 G1 winners in his first nine years of training before relocating to Hong Kong. Millard made an immediate impact locally, winning the 2000 Hong Kong Derby in his first season with Keen Winner. His most spectacular successes in Hong Kong have come with two-time Horse of the Year Ambitious Dragon whose 13 career wins included two G1s and five local G1s. **Honours:** South African Champion Trainer (1992, 1994 [shared with Pat Shaw]). **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** FWD QEII Cup (2011 Ambitious Dragon). **Hong Kong wins:** 612.

**Moore, John***FWDQEII – Eagle Way; CM – Beauty Generation*

Age: 69. John Moore has been involved in Hong Kong racing since the professional era commenced in 1971 and is Hong Kong's longest-serving and winning-most trainer. A former amateur jockey, he began training in 1985, before which he was assistant trainer to his late famous father, George. In 2007 he prepared an international G1 double thanks to Viva Pataca in the QEII Cup and Able One in the Champions Mile and, in a feat perhaps unprecedented in the sport, won the same two races with the same two horses three years later. He was the first to saddle 1000 wins in Hong Kong and was the leading prize money earner in 12 of the past 13 seasons. The stable has also produced the last six gallopers to be named Hong Kong Horse of the Year – Military Attack, Designs On Rome, Able Friend, Werther, Rapper Dragon and Beauty Generation. **Honours:** 7x Hong Kong Champion Trainer (1985/86, 1990/91, 1991/92, 1992/93 [tied with David Hill], 1994/95, 2010/11, 2014/15); Hong Kong record holder for all-time career prize money (HK\$1.87 billion). **FWD Champions Day race wins (16):** FWD QEII Cup (2007 & 2010 Viva Pataca, 2013 Military Attack, 2014 Designs On Rome, 2016 Werther), FWD Champions Mile (2007 & 2010 Able One, 2011 & 2012 Xtension, 2013 Dan Excel, 2015 Able Friend, 2018 Beauty Generation), Chairman's Sprint Prize (1994 Happy Money, 2006 Billet Express, 2009 & 2011 Dim Sum). **Hong Kong wins: 1648.**

**O'Sullivan, Paul***FWDQEII – Pakistan Star*


Age: 59. Paul O'Sullivan arrived in Hong Kong in 2004 and has enjoyed major successes with Vital King (Hong Kong Derby), Fellowship (Stewards' Cup) and champion sprinter Aerovelocity (G1 wins include Hong Kong Sprint x2), who during the 2014/15 season became the first Hong Kong horse to win three G1s in three different international jurisdictions. O'Sullivan was champion trainer in New Zealand on 11 occasions, acting in partnership with his father Dave for 17 years. His brother, Lance, New Zealand's all-time winning-most jockey, is also a trainer. O'Sullivan won the G1 Japan Cup in 1989 with Horlicks, ridden by his brother, and added scores of other majors on both sides of the Tasman Sea, including the G1 Cox Plate with Surfers Paradise in 1991. **Honours:** 11-time New Zealand Champion Trainer. **Hong Kong wins: 425.**

**Pitman, Michael***CSP – Enzo's Lad*

Age: 63. Michael Pitman spent much of his youth at Riccarton Park racecourse with his parents before electing to take out his owner-trainer licence over four decades ago. Pitman has consistently been in the top five in the New Zealand trainers' premiership and in the 2007/08 season he became the first South Island-based trainer in 36 years to win a premiership (86 wins). G1 success has followed in recent years, including Savvy Coup who claimed two G1's in 2018, winning the New Zealand Oaks and the Livamol Classic. Pitman's most recent G1 success came when Enzo's Lad won his second consecutive G1 Telegraph in January 2019. Pitman is based in at Riccarton, training in partnership with his son, Matthew Pitman. **Honours:** New Zealand Trainers' Premiership (2007/08). **Hong Kong wins:** No previous Hong Kong runners.

**Shum, Danny C S***CM – Seasons Bloom*

Age: 58. Danny Shum rode 24 winners in Hong Kong between 1977 and 1983. He learnt the training ropes as assistant to former multiple Hong Kong champion trainer Ivan Allan. He was granted a Hong Kong trainer's licence ahead of the 2003/04 season and began brightly with 34 winners. He improved on that good debut season to rank third in the trainers' premiership in his second term when Scintillation emerged as his standout runner. The 2011/12 season brought a first overseas success as Little Bridge went to Royal Ascot to clinch victory in the G1 King's Stand Stakes. Last term, he saddled Seasons Bloom to win the G1 Stewards' Cup. He recorded a best ever season's tally of 54 wins to finish second in the 2015/16 trainers' premiership. **Hong Kong wins: 569.**

**Size, John***FWDQEII – Dinozzo, Waikuku; CM – Conte; CSP – Beat The Clock*

Age: 64. John Size was a top trainer in Sydney before his arrival in Hong Kong in 2001. He broke the mould by winning the trainers' premiership in his very first season. Size notched his ninth championship in 2016/17, setting a new record for most wins in a season with 94, 27 more than nearest rival John Moore; and in 2017/18 he smashed Moore's record for most prize money in a season by more than HK\$21 million as his 87 wins accrued HK\$176 million. He has trained the winners of two Horse of the Year titles, the multiple HKG1 scorers Electronic Unicorn and Grand Delight. **Sugiura, Hiroaki***CSP – Nac Venus*

Age: 58. Born in Hokkaido, Hiroaki Sugiura commenced his career as a jockey in 1982. He rode a total of 209 wins until he hung up his boots and received his JRA trainer licence in 1995. His first G1 win came from Telegnosis in the 2002 NHK Mile Cup. He took the same horse to France to finish third in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and to Hong Kong for the Hong Kong Mile in 2003. Showa Modern brought him another important win in the G1 Yasuda Kinen in 2010. He has amassed a total of 365 JRA wins, including six this year. **Hong Kong wins:** 0

**Todd, Sir Mark***FWDQEII – Eminent*

Age: 53. Sir Mark Todd is New Zealand's most decorated Olympian, having competed at a record seven Olympic Games. Todd won gold twice in Individual Eventing, first at the 1984 Los Angeles games and his second at the 1988 Seoul games. He has trained racehorses on and off throughout his career and has enjoyed G1 success on two occasions. He trained Bramble Rose to victory in the 2003 New Zealand Oaks and won the 2007 Wellington Cup with Willy Smith. **Honours:** Seven-time Olympian (1984, 1988, 1992, 2000, 2008, 2012, 2016); two-time Olympic Gold Medallist (Eventing) **Hong Kong wins:** No previous Hong Kong runners.

**Yahagi, Yoshito***FWDQEII – Lys Gracieux*

Age: 58. Yoshito Yahagi grew up in the vicinity of Oi Racecourse in Tokyo, as his father Kazuto Yahagi was a trainer and jockey in the regional NAR circuit. Fond of racing, tennis and cycling as a teenager, Yahagi travelled to Australia to learn the skills of training at Randwick, Flemington and Toowoomba Racecourses, before coming back to Japan to start his career as a stable assistant in 1984. In 1990, he spent three months working with trainer Geoff Wragg in the UK. Yahagi received his JRA training licence in 2004 and has since become one of the top JRA trainers, having won the JRA Award twice as the Best Trainer, with most races won in 2014 and 2016. He has sent out no less than 582 JRA winners including 10 this season. Grand Prix Boss gave Yahagi his first career G1 wins in the 2010 Asahi Hai Futurity Stakes and 2011 NHK Mile Cup, followed by Deep Brillante's success in the 2012 Japanese Derby. He notched two more G1 wins last year, thanks to Mozu Ascot in the G1 Yasuda Kinen in June, and most recently Lys Gracieux in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in November. **Hong Kong wins:** 0

**Yung, Benno T P***CSP – Pingwu Spark*

Age: 60. Benno Yung started out at the Hong Kong Jockey Club as an apprentice jockey in 1978 and rode professionally in Hong Kong until 1986, the final four years as a senior jockey. He was first appointed assistant trainer in 1991, working under Christopher Cheung. He then spent two seasons in the same role for Tony Millard until moving to the John Size stable when the Australian first arrived in 2001. Yung remained in that role until receiving a licence to train ahead of the 2013/14 season. His first season yielded 37 winners at a strike rate of 11%. His stable standout so far has been the giant grey Pingwu Spark, a five-time winner and G2 placed. **Hong Kong wins:** 174.

Bayliss, Regan

Age: 21. Regan Bayliss is the son of former jockey and trainer Jamie Bayliss and brother to fellow rider Jake Bayliss. He was raised around horses, riding ponies after school and spending time at the Peter Moody stable from age 13. He was apprenticed to Moody before moving on to join the David Hayes, Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes operation. 133 of his more than 350 wins in Australia have come in tandem with the Hayes/Dabernig team. His first ride was aboard Alana's Dream at Donald in July 2013 and he rode out his claim with a treble at Flemington on 17 December, 2016. He has three G1 wins on the board: Newmarket Handicap (2017 & 2018 Redkirk Warrior), Black Caviar Lightning (2018 Redkirk Warrior). Bayliss has ridden in Britain, the USA and the UAE and has been based in Hong Kong since February this year. **Hong Kong wins:** 3



Bowditch, Joe

Age: 42. Originally from Wagga, New South Wales, Joe Bowditch began his apprenticeship in Sydney with the late Ray Guy at age 15 in 1992. Bowditch rode his first winner at Randwick but soon after moved to Adelaide and rode for David Hayes. Bowditch remained in Adelaide for a number of years following the departure of Hayes who relocated to Hong Kong. Bowditch secured his first G1 aboard Hard To Get in the 2004 South Australian Derby for trainer Mark Kavanagh. He has been Lloyd Kennewell's stable rider for over a decade and the pair have enjoyed G1 success twice together with Viddora in the 2017 Winterbottom Stakes and the Moir Stakes. Bowditch has ridden over 1200 winners across his career and notched multiple stakes wins in Queensland during the early 2000's. **Hong Kong wins:** No previous rides



Bowman, Hugh

Age: 38. The 2017 LONGINES World's Best Jockey award recipient, Bowman boasts an outstanding career record of 88 G1 victories among more than 2,000 wins since his debut ride on Naturalised in 1999. He has been champion jockey in Sydney four times and the most prolific G1-winning jockey in Australia for each of the past three seasons. He has a record of 32 wins from 33 rides on the champion mare Winx, notably an incredible four wins in the Cox Plate. In Hong Kong, he has won the Hong Kong Derby (2016 Werther, 2019 Furore), Hong Kong Gold Cup (2016 Werther) and Champions & Chater Cup (2016 Werther). Callan, Neil

Age: 40. Irishman Neil Callan finished runner-up in the British jockeys' championship in 2005 (151 wins) and 2007 (170 wins). After a fruitless start as an apprentice in Ireland with Kevin Prendergast he moved to Britain and forged successful partnerships with trainers Karl Burke, Kevin Ryan and Michael Jarvis. He first rode in Hong Kong on a short contract in the 2010/11 season and has since established a reputation as a tough competitor. His first full Hong Kong season, 2014/15, yielded 47 wins and fifth place in the jockeys' premiership and he equalled that tally when finishing third in 2016/17. Chadwick, Matthew

Age: 28. A graduate of Hong Kong's Apprentice Jockeys' School, Matthew Chadwick went to Australia for his apprentice training and rode a four-timer at Lismore Racecourse at age 17. Indentured to the Tony Cruz stable upon his return to Hong Kong, he was champion apprentice in 2008/09. He earned a full jockey's licence in January, 2010. His first Group race winner was Egyptian Ra in the HKG3 National Day Cup (2009). Chadwick became the first homegrown rider to win a HKIR contest when clinching the G1 Hong Kong Cup on California Memory in 2011 and followed up on the same horse in the same race in 2012. He rode his first Hong Kong four-timer at Sha Tin on 22 June, 2014. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Apprentice (2008/09); Shergar Cup Silver Saddle winner (2012). **Hong Kong wins:** 346



Clark, Tim

Age: 32. Tim Clark was born in Leeton, New South Wales and began his career apprenticed to Peter Clancy. Clark rode his first winner aboard Tactica at Gundagai on 21 November, 2003, before moving to Sydney, where he was crowned champion apprentice in 2005/06. He landed his first G1 victory on Typhoon Zed in The Galaxy at Royal Randwick in 2008. He won the 2011 G1 Doncaster Mile on Sacred Choice and in the very next race took a second The Galaxy on Atomic Force. He also struck up a successful partnership with the mare Hot Danish, winning the G1 All Aged Stakes and the G1 Doomben 10,000. Clark has ridden over 1000 winners overall in Australia, including 11 G1's, his most recent the G1 Flight Stakes at Randwick aboard Ooohood. He is no stranger to Hong Kong and spent almost two seasons here in 2011/12 and 2012/13, tallying 59 wins. His Hong Kong feature wins include Jacobee's HKG3 Sa Sa Ladies' Purse success, Destined For Glory's G2 Jockey Club Mile victory and It Has To Be You's Classic Cup success of 2013. **Honours:** Sydney champion apprentice (2006). **Hong Kong wins:** 59



Ho, Vincent C Y

Age: 28. HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School graduate Vincent Ho racked up 44 wins as a young rider in New Zealand under the tutelage of leading trainer Lance O'Sullivan. He made a good start to his Hong Kong career with 10 victories in his first season in 2009/10, including a trio of wins he achieved on only his fourth race day in Hong Kong. He sealed the 2010/11 Champion Apprentice title with 39 wins. Ho reached the graduation benchmark on 1 October, 2012 by claiming his 70th win in Hong Kong on board Castle Hero. He notched 33 wins in 2014/15 to be the season's leading homegrown rider. He rode a short stint in Europe during the off-season in 2018 and notched a first UK win at the first attempt, partnering the Mark Johnston-trained X Rated to success at Haydock on 9 August. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Apprentice (2010/11); Best Freelance Jockey Award (2014/15). **Hong Kong wins:** 250



Leung, Derek K C

Age: 30. Derek Leung's career highlight is his 2017 LONGINES Hong Kong Mile victory aboard Beauty Generation. A product of Hong Kong's Apprentice Jockeys' School, he cut his teeth in New Zealand under trainer Lance O'Sullivan. He was assigned as apprentice jockey to Paul O'Sullivan's stable upon his return to Hong Kong. Leung reached the graduation benchmark after his 70th win on board Star Of Fame on 1 June, 2011. He reached a personal best total of 33 wins in the 2015/16 season and received the Tony Cruz Award in 2016/17 and 2017/18 as the leading home-grown rider. His biggest win came in the 2017 Hong Kong Mile on Beauty Generation. **Honours:** Asian Young Guns Challenge winner (2010); Tony Cruz Award winner (2017 & 2018). **Hong Kong wins:** 272



Matsuoka, Masami

Age: 34. A baseball lover and a musician in a band, Matsuoka commenced his JRA jockey career in 2003 and he obtained the first of his 33 Pattern race wins atop Win Glanz in the 2005 G3 Diamond Stakes. Matsuoka chose to travel to Ireland in 2006, to work for trainer John Oxx for three months. He earned his first G1 win the following year, atop Koiuta in the JPN G1 Victoria Mile, before adding another important win with Meiner Kitz in the 2009 G1 Tenno Sho Spring. He also partnered Bamboo Ere to win the JPN G1 JBC Sprint in 2008. Matsuoka has amassed a total of 813 JRA wins, including seven this year.

McDonald, James

Age: 27. James McDonald made a big impression in Hong Kong when finishing second to Frankie Dettori on his LONGINES IJC debut when still a teenager back in 2011. He returned the following May and partnered Xtension to victory in the 2012 G1 Champions Mile at Sha Tin. Champion Apprentice in his homeland, he went on to claim the Premiership there twice, in 2008/09 and latterly with a New Zealand record tally of 207 for the 2010/11 season. In 2012 he won a first New Zealand Derby. He clinched his first Sydney Premiership in July, 2014. He was appointed Godolphin's number one rider in Australia in March 2015 but lost that role when in December 2016 he was disqualified for 18 months due to a breach of betting rules. He returned to race-riding in May 2018 and landed his 40th and most recent G1 on Verry Elleegant in the ATC Oaks this month. **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** FWD Champions Mile (2012 Xtension). **Honours:** Two-time Sydney champion jockey (2013/14, 2015/16); two-time New Zealand champion jockey (2008/09, 2010/11). **Hong Kong wins:** 5




Moreira, Joao

Age: 34. Brazilian Joao Moreira notched more than 1000 wins in South America. He relocated to Singapore in 2009 and dominated the Singapore circuit for four years. He moved to Hong Kong in October, 2013 and has been champion jockey three times with record-breaking win totals (145, 168 and 170). **Honours:** Three-time Hong Kong Champion Jockey (2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17); LONGINES IJC winner (2012); Japan's World All-Star Jockeys winner (2015); four-time Singapore Champion Jockey (2010, 2011, 2012, 2013); two-time Brazilian Eclipse Award winner (2006/07, 2007/08); fastest 100 in a Hong Kong season (22 February, 2017); Hong Kong record for most wins in a season (170 in 2016/17); most wins in a Hong Kong race day (eight: 5 March, 2017); Singapore record for most wins in a season (206 in 2012); eight wins from eight rides at Kranji (6 September, 2013); eight wins in a day at Cidade Jardim (March, 2006). **FWD Champions Day race wins (3):** FWD QEII Cup (2017 Neorealism), Champions Mile (2015 Able Friend, 2016 Maurice). **Hong Kong wins:** 772



Murphy, Oisin

Age: 23. Oisin Murphy is Qatar Racing's retained rider in Europe. The Killarney native is a graduate of the Irish pony racing circuit. Schooled in riding by his uncle, the Cheltenham Gold Cup-winning jockey Jim Culloty, Murphy worked summer holidays for trainers Tommy Stack and Aidan O'Brien. He was apprenticed to Andrew Balding in October 2012 and had his first race ride in May 2013 when already 18. He ended his first season (2013) with 41 wins, including a four-timer on Ayr Gold Cup day that featured the historic sprint handicap itself. Murphy impressed in winter stints in Australia and the UAE before riding on a short contract in Hong Kong in the winter of 2016/17, which brought four wins. His G1 breakthrough came in October, 2017 on Aclaim in the Prix de la Foret and two weeks later he took the G1 E P Taylor Stakes on Blond Me. He had nine G1 wins in 2018, including four on Roaring Lion. **Honours:** UK Champion Apprentice (2014) **Hong Kong wins:** 5



Purton, Zac

Age: 36. Zac Purton is Hong Kong's current Champion Jockey. Having ended Douglas Whyte's 13-season dominance with his first Hong Kong jockeys' championship in 2013/14 (112 wins), in 2017/18 he halted Joao Moreira's title streak at three. His second championship was a remarkable effort as he chased down Moreira to take the lead for the first time that term on June 10, 2018. Five weeks later, at season's end, he had outpointed Moreira 136-134 with a win strike rate of 21% to the Brazilian's 20%. Purton started his career in Brisbane and was an apprentice sensation, winning the premiership there in 2003. Purton moved to Hong Kong in September, 2007. His many major wins include the King's Stand Stakes at Royal Ascot in 2012 on Hong Kong's Little Bridge. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Jockey (2013/14, 2017/18); Brisbane Champion Jockey (2003 - when still an apprentice); LONGINES IJC (2017); World Super Jockeys Series (Japan) winner (2012). **FWD Champions Day race wins (2):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2018 Ivictory), FWD Champions Mile (2018 Beauty Generation) **Hong Kong wins:** 956



Rispoli, Umberto

Age: 30. Italian jockey Umberto Rispoli commenced his apprenticeship in 2005 and graduated to the senior ranks in 2010. He is a two-time Champion Jockey in Italy. In winning his first Italian title, in 2009, he rode 245 winners and so smashed the longstanding previous record of 229. Rispoli, who has also ridden in Japan, notched six wins in his first Hong Kong season in 2011/12, crowned by G1 QEII Cup success on the Japanese galloper Rulership. After moving to trainer Mikel Delzangles in France, he took a further G1 atop Molly Malone in the Prix du Cadran. Rispoli has since returned to Hong Kong on short-term licences. He broke a leg three meetings into his 2016/17 winter contract but was back in action within two and a half months and ended the term with 15 wins. **Honours:** Italian Champion Jockey (2009 & 2010). **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** FWD QEII Cup (2012 Rulership). **Hong Kong wins:** 112



Schofield, Chad

Age: 25. Chad Schofield spent four years (2002-2006) of his youth living in Hong Kong where his father, the South African jockey Glyn Schofield, was contracted to ride. His family relocated to Australia and Schofield commenced his own riding career in Sydney in the 2010/11 season. He moved to Melbourne in 2012 to ride for the powerful David Hayes stable. His first G1 win was a major, the 2013 Cox Plate on Shamus Award and he also won the 2014 G1 Newmarket Handicap on Lankan Rupee. He and his father made history in 2014 as the first father and son to compete against each other in the Melbourne Cup and at Sha Tin on 14 February, 2016 they became the first in Hong Kong to ride against each other. He rode Singapore Sling to win the Hong Kong Classic Cup in 2018. **Honours:** Sydney Champion Apprentice (2011/12); Melbourne Champion Apprentice (2012/13). **Hong Kong wins:** 126



Take, Yutaka

Age: 50. **Background:** Take is the son of famed jockey Kunihito Take and is a living legend in Japan, with more than 4,000 wins in his homeland and overseas. He has been champion jockey in Japan 18 times and was the first jockey to ride eight winners in a day in Japan, a feat achieved in December 2002. He became the first Japanese jockey to win a G1 race in Europe when Ski Paradise captured the 1994 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp . In 2000 he spent time riding in the US and in 2001 he was based with trainer John Hammond in France. His 111 G1 wins include four Japan Cups with Special Week (1999), Deep Impact (2006), Rose Kingdom (2010) and Kitasan Black (2016), and his latest atop Inti in the G1 February Stakes this year. His overseas achievements include the Hong Kong Cup (2015 A Shin Hikari) and Hong Kong Vase (2001 Stay Gold). In winning the G3 Sirius Stakes in October 2015 he became the first rider to win 300 JRA Graded races in Japan. With 38 wins, he currently sits third in the JRA's jockey standing this year. **Hong Kong wins:** 4



Teetan, Karis

Age: 28. Mauritian rider Karis Teetan arrived in Hong Kong in August, 2013. After entering the South African Jockey Academy at the age of 14 Teetan went on to be crowned Champion South African Apprentice in 2008. He graduated in 2009 with 147 wins to his credit. Teetan passed the 100-win mark in every season as a senior jockey in South Africa. He has recorded five Group 1 wins, with his inaugural success at the top level being in his native Mauritius on 24 November, 2008, aboard Halo Hunter. Teetan notched an impressive 50 wins in his first Hong Kong season and has partnered to victory two of Hong Kong's all-time heroes, Able Friend and Designs On Rome. He is currently second on the Hong Kong premiership. **Honours:** South African Champion Apprentice (2008). **Hong Kong wins:** 284



- Jockeys participating in the nominated races in a race meeting will be numbered as 1 to 14. Nos. 1 to 13 (Named Jockey) will be assigned to one jockey each, while No. 14 (Others) will include the rest of the jockeys for the race meeting.
- Jockeys riding the first three placed horses on their Scheduled Rides will earn Jockey Challenge Points – 12, 6 and 4 points respectively. Scheduled Rides means the rides that a jockey is engaged to ride in the nominated races at a race meeting at the start selling of Jockey Challenge.
- Jockey Challenge Points scored by Substitute Jockeys will not count.
- At the end of a race meeting, the jockey with the highest accumulated Jockey Challenge Points will be declared as the winner. The Jockey Challenge Points for all jockeys (including jockeys in No. 14) will be counted on an individual basis.
- The “countback” rule will be used as a tie-breaker should two or more jockeys collect the same number of Jockey Challenge Points on their Scheduled Rides.
