Indeed, that general position has a surprising success rate, with past winners such as Glorious Days, Ambitious Dragon, Good Ba Ba, Olympic Express and Eishin Preston all settling back and wide. Ka Ying Star looks the obvious leader this year and he might get that position unchallenged, so the pace should only be moderate.
