FWD Champions Day at Sha Tin Racecourse on Sunday, 25 April will bring together the very best of Hong Kong's elite gallopers and a top-line contingent from Japan in three exciting Group 1 races.

The brilliant Golden Sixty will look to extend his unblemished run to 14 wins when he contests the HK\$20 million G1 FWD Champions Mile (1600m), Japan's Fillies' Triple Crown winner Daring Tact clashes with reigning Hong Kong Horse of the Year Exultant in the HK\$25 million G1 FWD QEII Cup (2000m), while Danon Smash returns following his December triumph in search of more Hong Kong riches in the HK\$18 million G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize (1200m).

A total of 27 talented horses from both Hong Kong and Japan, including nine individual G1 winners, have been selected to compete in the three races worth HK\$63 million.

Race one will commence at 12:45 p.m. with the first of the Group 1 races, the Chairman's Sprint Prize, set for 2:50 p.m.

## Fast Facts

1

Mr Stunning brought jockey Karis Teetan a second G1 success in Hong Kong with victory in this race last year. Teetan partnered the same horse for his first G1 win in Hong Kong in the 2018 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint.

2

Only three horses have won this race at odds greater than 20/1 since 1985, namely Billet Express (24/1) in 2006, Dim Sum (50/1) in 2011 and last year's winner Mr Stunning (20/1).

3

Australian-bred runners have won this race 22 times since 1985, including the last five renewals since 2016.

4

The race was ranked equal 47th in the 2020 World's Top 100 G1 Races, on par with another local premier G1 sprint, the Centenary Sprint Cup.

5

At five wins, Gate 5 has produced the most winners of the race since 1985, the last victor coming from that barrier being Beat The Clock in 2019.

6

Beat The Clock in 2019 stopped the clock at 1m 08.26s, the second fastest winning time since 1985, just six hundredths of a second slower than Absolute Champion's winning time in 2007 (1m 08.20s).

7

John Size became the second trainer to complete a one-two-three finish in this race with Ivictory, Mr Stunning and Beat The Clock in 2018. Ivan Allan was the first to achieve the feat with Fairy King Prawn, Cliffhanger and Plenty-Plenty in the 2001 renewal.

8

Australian sprinter Chautauqua created history when he became the first overseas horse to win this race in 2016, the first time the race was opened to international competition.

9

Quicken Away is the only horse to have won the Chairman's Sprint Prize three times (1989, 1990 & 1991). Seven others since 1985 have won the race twice, the latest being Lucky Nine in 2013 & 2014.

10

Only three four-year-olds have won this race since 2000, Silent Witness (2004), Sacred Kingdom (2008) and Ivictory (2018).

11

Fairy King Prawn's success in 1999 is the last time a three-year-old won the Chairman's Sprint Prize.

12

Legendary sprinter Silent Witness extended his unbeaten streak to 16 when he won his second Chairman's Sprint Prize in 2005. That victory also equalled the world record at the time for the modern era of career runs unbeaten.

13

Top favourites have won 16 of the past 36 runnings of the Chairman's Sprint Prize, including 11 that started even-money or shorter and the shortest-priced winner Silent Witness at 1/20 in 2005.

14

Basil Marcus is the most successful jockey in the race's history, having won five times. His first win aboard Concert King in 1992 denied Quicken Away what would have been an incredible fourth win in the race.

15

Ivan Allan and John Moore are the most successful Chairman's Sprint Prize trainers with six and four wins, followed by active trainers John Size and Ricky Yiu at three wins each.

16

Tony Cruz rode Ever Win to victory in the inaugural version of this race in April, 1979. He has notched four more victories in this race, two as a jockey and two as a trainer – including Silent Witness in 2005.

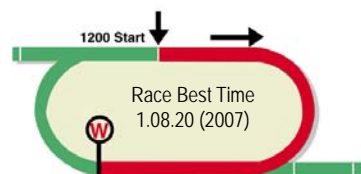

COMPUTER PATCH looks the likely leader here, from BEAUTY APPLAUSE. In the history of the race, it's typically been on-pace runners who have won this race, with the exception of Chautauqua, who came from last with a devastating finishing sprint. VOYAGE WARRIOR, AMAZING STAR and BIG PARTY can all race prominently. At midfield, we should have the Japanese visitor DANON SMASH, together with STRONGER and the up-and-comer WELLINGTON. With COMPUTER PATCH engaged, the speed should be decent.

## Spotlight

Danon Smash, winner of December's G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint (1200m) is aiming to add another top-level victory in Hong Kong to his growing resume when he contests the G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize. His record, which now also features last month's G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen (1200m) at Chukyo Racecourse, is growing rapidly and he tops the billing for this month's HK\$18 million dash.

But there is no shortage of talent in Hong Kong bidding to stop him. Jolly Banner, who finished second to Danon Smash in last year's G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint is entered, while Wellington, who clocked an equal Class 1 record to that of the legendary Sacred Kingdom also lines up.

A trio of G2 winners also feature - Wishful Thinker, who claimed this season's Premier Bowl (1200m) is engaged, as is Rattan, the 2019 G2 Sprint Cup (1200m) victor, while Voyage Warrior, the winner of the 2020 G2 Sprint Cup (1200m), takes his place.

Trainer Frankie Lor, who won this race last year with Mr Stunning, will be represented by a pair of talents, the G3-winning Big Party and Fat Turtle, fifth in last year's G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint.

Computer Patch, a G3 winner down the straight features, as does Sky Field and three supplementary entries, the first three across the line in the G2 Sprint Cup (1200m), Amazing Star, Stronger and Beauty Applause, respectively, rounding out the 13-runner field.

## Race History

Sha Tin Racecourse opened its doors in October, 1978, and in line with that new era for Hong Kong racing an elite 1200m contest was inaugurated. That first edition on 29 April, 1979 was titled the Hong Kong Sprint Championship but a more familiar moniker, the Chairman's Prize, was introduced a year later. The Arthur Ward-trained Ever Win took the first running under Tony Cruz.

By 1989, when Quicken Away won the first of three consecutive renewals, the race was a million-dollar affair: that year's contest was worth HK\$1.032 million, with only the Hong Kong Invitation Cup and Hong Kong Derby holding higher purses. Three years later, it attained HKG1 status and in the 1993/94 season, when the Champion Sprint Series was established, the Chairman's Prize took its natural place as one of the three legs.

It was in 2001 that the race title became the Chairman's Sprint Prize and the purse that year was HK\$4.5 million. In 2007 the race shifted to February from a March/April slot in the calendar, thus becoming the second leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series. The 2016 edition was the first time it was run as an international G1 contest, with prize money upped to HK\$10 million. The race was shifted to an April/May date - as the final leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series - to fill the void left by Singapore's discontinued KrisFlyer International Sprint.

The race was ranked equal 47th in the World's Top 100 G1 Races in 2020 and prize money of the six furlong contest was further increased to HK\$18 million last year.

Notable winners of the Chairman's Sprint Prize include world champion sprinters Silent Witness (2004 & 2005) and Sacred Kingdom (2008 & 2010), as well as Fairy King Prawn (1999 & 2001), Joy And Fun (2012) and Lucky Nine (2013 & 2014). In 2016, Australian sensation Chautauqua became the first internationally-trained winner of the race. Local speedsters Lucky Bubbles, Ivictory, Beat The Clock and Mr Stunning have taken the spoils in the past four renewals of the race.

That win saw Beauty Generation tally HK\$84,770,000 total prize money, elevating him above Viva Pataca as the all-time highest earning horse in Hong Kong. He went on to become the first horse with career earnings over HK\$100 million, at HK\$106,233,750.

7

2019 winner Beauty Generation was the first horse to complete the Hong Kong Mile-Champions Mile double in consecutive seasons (2017/18 & 2018/19). Good Ba Ba (2007/08), Able Friend (2014/15) and Maurice (2015/16) are the only other horses to have completed the double in a single season.

8

Beauty Generation joined Xtension (2011 & 2012), Able One (2007 & 2010) and Bullish Luck (2005 & 2006) as the four horses to have won the Champions Mile twice.

9

Beauty Generation, sent off at odds of 1.05 in 2019, is the shortest-priced winner in the race's history. He was also the sixth market favourite to have won this race.

10

Beauty Generation's trainer John Moore has eight wins and is the most successful trainer in this race.

11

Brett Prebble is the race's most successful jockey at three wins, followed by Zac Purton, Joao Moreira, Weichong Marwing and Darren Beadman with two wins each.

12

The FWD Champions Mile purse increased to HK\$20 million in 2020, four times more than the HK\$4.6 million on offer in 2001.

13

Some 32 overseas horses from eight countries (Australia, France, Britain, Japan, Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa and UAE) have contested the race since it was opened to international runners in 2005.

14

2016 winner Maurice is one of only three overseas horses to have won three races in Hong Kong (France's Jim And Tonic and Japan's Eishin Preston are the others). His Champions Mile victory came five months after his success in the 2015 Hong Kong Mile and he completed the trio when taking the Hong Kong Cup later in 2016.

15

Maurice (2016) and Variety Club (2014) are the only two overseas winners of the FWD Champions Mile. Variety Club won by four lengths, the largest winning margin in the race's history.

16

Casino Prince is the only three-year-old to have contested the race since it became an international event in 2005. This Australian galloper finished last in the 2007 renewal.

## Spotlight

Golden Sixty was imperious when winning the 2020 G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Mile and the brilliant son of Medaglia d'Oro will step down in distance after claiming February's G1 Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup (2000m) to contest the G1 FWD Champions Mile.

While two legs of Hong Kong's Triple Crown are in the bag and the third, the G1 Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup (2400m) is set for the end of May, the new pin-up boy of Hong Kong racing will in the meantime look to extend his record to 14 consecutive wins in the FWD Champions Mile, with a view to also winning his fourth G1 race in succession.

But there is no shortage of opposition to Francis Lui's standout charge, with six selected to run including last year's winner of the race, Southern Legend, a consistent jetsetter who has two international successes to his name in Singapore and, was narrowly touched off by Golden Sixty three starts ago in the G1 Stewards' Cup (1600m) by a head.

Also included in the small but select field is the four-year-old Healthy Happy, winner of the Hong Kong Classic Cup (1800m).

The home team also features Ka Ying Star, last-start G2 Chairman's Trophy all-the-way winner Mighty Giant and More Than This.

## Race History

The FWD Champions Mile is the only one of Hong Kong's 12 Group 1 contests to have been established after the turn of the millennium. That first edition came in 2001 and carried a purse of HK\$4.6 million. The race was initially a HKG1 contest, designed as a finale for Hong Kong's star milers, and it was the Brian Kan-trained Red Pepper that scored under Eric Legrix.

International runners were first welcomed in 2005 when the prize money rose to HK\$8 million. In a classic clash of the titans, Bullish Luck edged his great stablemate Silent Witness. That result ended the latter's unbeaten streak that had stretched through 17 races. Bullish Luck became the first two-time winner when he followed-up in 2006.

The Champions Mile attained international G1 status in 2007 and Able One took the spoils, the first of eight wins for the race's most successful trainer John Moore. The Moore-trained galloper triumphed again in 2010, by which time the race was worth HK\$12 million (increased in 2009). Moore rattled off six more wins with Xtension (2011 & 2012), Dan Excel (2013), the great champion Able Friend (2015) and two-time Horse of the Year Beauty Generation (2018 & 2019).

The Caspar Fownes-trained Southern Legend denied Beauty Generation a record three-peat in this race last year, with his rider Vincent Ho also notching a first career G1. The race's total prize money was increased to the current level of HK\$20 million in 2020. The race was ranked equal 51st in the IFHA World's Top 100 G1s in 2020.

South Africa's Variety Club, trained by Mike de Kock, became the first overseas raider to win the FWD Champions Mile in 2014, defeating hot favourite Able Friend. Japanese galloper Maurice joined that list in 2016 when the Champions Mile formed the middle leg of a stellar treble in Hong Kong that included his wins in the 2015 Hong Kong Mile (1600m) and the 2016 Hong Kong Cup (2000m). Other notable winners down the years include Good Ba Ba (2008) and Electronic Unicorn (2003). Insurance brand FWD became the Champions Mile's title sponsor in 2019.

## Fast Facts

1

Zac Purton claimed his first FWD QEII Cup win atop Exultant last year and became the first jockey in history to have won each of the 12 G1 contests on the Hong Kong racing calendar.

2

Tony Cruz saddled a one-two finish with Exultant and Furore in the QEII Cup last year, his second in three years after Pakistan Star and Gold Mount finished first and second in the 2018 renewal. John Moore was the only other trainer to have achieved the same feat with Designs On Rome and Military Attack in 2014.

3

Successful in 2015 with Blazing Speed and 2018 with Pakistan Star, Exultant's win in last year's edition means Tony Cruz (three wins) is currently the most successful active trainer in the QEII Cup, while John Moore is the most successful of all time (five wins).

4

As a 1.5 chance, Exultant is the fourth favourite to win the QEII Cup since it became a 2000m contest in 1997, the others being Designs On Rome in 2014, Ambitious Dragon in 2011 and Eishin Preston in 2003.

5

The QEII Cup's total prize money increased to HK\$25 million in 2020 and is currently the joint second richest race in Hong Kong alongside the Hong Kong Mile. The HK\$28 million Hong Kong Cup is the richest.

6

2019 winner Win Bright gave Japan a third success in the past decade and a fifth overall. Neorealism (2017), Rulership (2012) and Eishin Preston (2002 & 2003) are the other Japanese QEII Cup winners, making Japan the overseas jurisdiction with most wins.

7

Three out of the five Japanese winners of the FWD QEII Cup, namely Win Bright, Neorealism and Eishin Preston in 2002, contested the G2 Nakayama Kinen at their last start before their triumph in Hong Kong.

8

Win Bright posted a Sha Tin's 2000m record time of 1m 58.81s in the 2019 QEII Cup. Each of the first eight runners behind Win Bright finished the 2000m trip in under two minutes.

9

At 47/1, Win Bright is the second longest-priced winner of the FWD QEII Cup since it became an international race in 1995, following 2004 winner River Dancer at 57/1.

10

South African raider Irridescence, successful in 2006, is the only filly or mare to have won the FWD QEII Cup. Since then eight more fillies or mares have taken part in the race, with Lys Gracieux, third in the 2019 renewal, the only one with Top 3 finish.

11

Pakistan Star in 2018 is the only Hong Kong International Sale graduate to have won the FWD QEII Cup.

12

With his 2017 winner Neorealism, Japanese trainer Noriyuki Hori becomes the first overseas trainer to win five G1s in Hong Kong.

13

Four horses – Werther (2016), Designs On Rome (2014), Ambitious Dragon (2011) and Vengeance Of Rain (2005) - have completed the Hong Kong Derby and FWD QEII Cup double in the same year.

14

Werther's four and a half length win in 2016 was the largest winning margin since it became a 2000m contest.

15

Hong Kong's Viva Pataca (2007 & 2010) and Japanese raider Eishin Preston (2002 & 2003) are the only two horses to have won the FWD QEII Cup twice.

16

With three wins apiece, Douglas Whyte (2011 Ambitious Dragon, 1998 Oriental Express, 1997 London News) and Mick Kinane (2007 Viva Pataca, 1995 Red Bishop, 1994 Deerfield) are the winning-most jockeys in recent FWD QEII Cup history.

## Spotlight

Reigning Horse of the Year Exultant will meet Japan's Daring Tact in a clash of old and young over the famed 2000m at Sha Tin in the G1 FWD QEII Cup. A seven-year-old now, the Irish-bred son of Teofilo, Exultant, will aim to capture his sixth win at the top-level and second FWD QEII Cup in succession. Against him, Japan's sixth Fillies' Triple Crown victor Daring Tact, who in turn bids to become the sixth Japanese winner of the FWD QEII Cup as she steps out onto international soil for the first time as a brilliant winner over 1600m, 2000m and 2400m in her home country.

Not least, she also finished third to super mare Almond Eye in the 2020 Japan Cup (2400m) and, fifth out of that race, Glory Vase, the 2019 G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Vase (2400m) hero will also feature, as well as Japanese Classic winner Loves Only You and the enigmatic Kiseki – a brazen son of 2012 QEII Cup winner Rulership.

Trainer Tony Cruz's game veteran Exultant is one of eight selected for the 2000m feature, which includes six G1 winners in total and his presence is bolstered by the inclusion of stablemates Time Warp and Furore, the former is a two-time G1 Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup (2000m) winner while the latter reigned supreme in the 2019 BMW Hong Kong Derby (2000m).

The improving Glorious Dragon, winner of the G3 Centenary Vase Handicap (1800m) and last-start course and distance winner, also lines up.

## Race History

In 1975 the British monarch Queen Elizabeth II arrived in Hong Kong for a state visit. To mark the event, on 5 May, the Hong Kong Jockey Club staged the inaugural running of the Queen Elizabeth II Cup, with a prize fund of HK\$50,000. Her Majesty was in attendance at Happy Valley and presented the winning trophy to Mr. and Mrs. Barma, whose horse Nazakat had prevailed in the 1575m sand track handicap under Malaysian rider A. K. Cheam for trainer Cheung Hok-man.

The race continued as a handicap for 17 years, its distance switching between 1400m, a mile, 1800m, and once at 2000m in April 1986. The race, which moved to Sha Tin in 1979, was in fact staged twice in 1986, first in April and then in October when the Queen was once again in attendance, that time to see Forever Gold win a 1600m renewal.

In April 1992 the contest was raised to HKG2 level and River Verdon won that mile edition. Three years later the race was opened up to international competition, as a local G1 contest. The UAE trainer Hilal Ibrahim sent Red Bishop to carry off the then 2200m race under Mick Kinane. That win presaged the following year's victory of Overbury for the newly-formed Godolphin as trainer Saeed bin Suroor and jockey Frankie Dettori teamed up to clinch an early international conquest for Sheikh Mohammed's operation. In 1997 the QEII Cup's distance of 2000m was firmly established and a young Douglas Whyte partnered South Africa's London News to success. The first Hong Kong victory of the international era came one year later when Oriental Express triumphed.

The race attained international G2 status in 1999 before it became Hong Kong's fourth international G1 race in 2001, the year in which the German raider Silvano took the winner's share of the HK\$10 million purse under Andreas Suborics. That purse money leapt to HK\$14 million in 2002 when the race was included in the now defunct World Racing Championships series.











Hong Kong runners have won seven of the past 10 editions of the QEII Cup. Five of those home winners have claimed that same season's Horse of the Year title (2011 Ambitious Dragon; 2013 Military Attack; 2014 Designs On Rome; 2016 Werther & 2020 Exultant). The three QEII Cup overseas winners of the past decade all hail from Japan, namely Rulership (2012), Neorealism (2017) and Win Bright (2019).

Insurance brand FWD is the title sponsor of the QEII Cup and has been since 2019. The race's total prize money increased to HK\$25 million in 2020, making it the joint second-richest race on the Hong Kong racing calendar.

**Cruz, Tony**

*FWDQEII – Exultant, Furore, Time Warp; FWDCM – Ka Ying Star; CSP – Computer Patch*

**Age:** 64. Tony Cruz is a son of Johnny Cruz, a renowned rider from Hong Kong's amateur era. He was among the first intake of apprentices to the HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School when that facility opened in 1972. Cruz started his riding career in the 1973/74 season. He went on to be Hong Kong's champion jockey six times and rode 946 winners. Cruz also made his name at G1 level in Europe and notably partnered the great race mare Triptych. He was granted a Hong Kong trainer's licence in 1996 and first landed the trainers' title in 1999/2000. He regained the crown in 2005, setting a then record for a season's winners (91) and earnings (HK\$113m) in the process. He trained the great Hong Kong champion Silent Witness to win 17 consecutive races. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Jockey (1978/79, 1980/81, 1982/83, 1983/84, 1985/86, 1994/95); Hong Kong Champion Trainer (1999/00, 2004/05). **FWD Champions Day race wins (7):** FWD Champions Mile (2005 & 2006 Bullish Luck), FWD QEII Cup (2015 Blazing Speed, 2018 Pakistan Star, 2020 Exultant), Chairman's Sprint Prize (2004 & 2005 Silent Witness). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 1,334.

**Fownes, Caspar**

*FWDCM – Southern Legend; CSP – Sky Field*

**Age:** 53. Caspar Fownes assisted his late father Lawrie for several seasons before gaining his licence in 2003/04. He eclipsed his father's best season stats in his rookie year with 44 wins. In 2006/07 he won his first premiership and has since added two more. His third championship came in 2013/14 when his strong late charge brought three wins on the closing day to tie with John Size on 62 wins, and with one more second place than his rival he sealed the title on count-back. Fownes is particularly known for his fine record at Happy Valley where he has notched 514 career wins (as at 5 April), a tally second only to Hong Kong's longest-serving trainer John Moore. He has enjoyed overseas success in Singapore's G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint three times, firstly with Green Birdie in 2010, before Lucky Nine snared two in succession (2013 and 2014). Fownes' most recent exploits abroad have reaped consecutive SIN G1 Kranji Mile's with Southern Legend. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Trainer (2006/07, 2008/09, 2013/14). **FWD Champions Day race wins (3):** FWD Champions Mile (2020 Southern Legend), Chairman's Sprint Prize (2013 & 2014 Lucky Nine). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 942.

**Gibson, Richard**

*CSP – Rattan, Wellington*

**Age:** 51. Englishman Richard Gibson established himself as a Group 1 trainer in France before he arrived in Hong Kong ahead of the 2011/12 season. He gained a solid grounding in the art and science of training racehorses with Frenchmen Pascal Bary and Henri-Alex Pantall, as well as Americans Bill Mott and Gary Jones. He took out his first licence at Chantilly in 1996 and struck gold as early as 1999 when Lady Of Chad won the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac en route to becoming European Champion Juvenile Filly. He has trained the winners of eight G1s altogether, the highlights being Akeed Mofeed's and Doctor Dino's exploits in Hong Kong and the USA. His other high-class trainees prior to moving to Hong Kong include Marotta, Lune D'Or, Cut Quartz, Mores Wells, Swedish Shave, and for a short spell Dunaden. He also won the Hong Kong Derby with Akeed Mofeed. **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2015 Gold-Fun). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 252.

**Lor, Frankie F C**

*FWDCM – Healthy Happy; CSP – Big Party, Fat Turtle*

**Age:** 54. Frankie Lor began his career as a rider in Hong Kong, notching 27 wins between 1981 and 1995. He became a work rider and then an assistant to a number of trainers, most notably to two of Hong Kong's greats, John Moore and John Size. Lor was granted a full licence ahead of the 2017/18 Hong Kong racing season. His first win was achieved with his first runner, Yourthewonforme, in a Class 4 contest at the season opener on 3 September, 2017. Lor ended that campaign second in the premiership behind his old master John Size. His final tally of 65 wins surpassed Hong Kong's previous best first-season total, set by Size when winning his first Hong Kong trainers' championship in 2002. Lor landed his first G1 wins in only his second season, scooping a double at the 2018 LONGINES HKIR with Mr Stunning (Hong Kong Sprint) and Glorious Forever (Hong Kong Cup). That season also saw him sweep the 2019 Four-Year-Old Classic Series with Furore and Mission Tycoon. **FWD Champions Day race wins (1):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2020 Mr Stunning). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 223.

**Lui, Francis K W**

*FWDQEII – Glorious Dragon; FWDCM – Golden Sixty, More Than This*

**Age:** 62. Francis Lui graduated from the HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School to ride 36 winners as a licensed jockey between 1975 and 1982, and later became an assistant trainer. He received his own licence to train in 1996/97. Lui enjoyed his best season in 2019/20 when he not only challenged for the trainers' title but also won all three legs of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series with the brilliant Golden Sixty; the handler saddled the bay through 13 races unbeaten since last term. Lui ended the last season with a personal best of 63 wins to place third in the championship, four behind Ricky Yiu. Hello Pretty also provided the handler with one leg of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series when he won the Hong Kong Derby Trial in 2006, while his standout stable star prior to Golden Sixty was sprinter Lucky Bubbles, who gave the trainer his first Group 1 win in 2017 when he took the Chairman's Sprint Prize. **FWD Champions Day race win (1):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (2017 Lucky Bubbles). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 729.



**Ozeki, Tomohito***FWDQEII – Glory Vase*

**Age:** 49. After graduating from his vet studies at university, Ozeki joined the JRA and started out as a groom in 1999. He obtained his JRA trainer licence in 2008 and established his own stable the following year. He has notched 298 JRA wins so far in his career, including six this term (as of 1 April). Red Falx gave him his first G1 success in the 2016 Sprinters Stakes before that same horse won the race for a second time the following year. Glory Vase brought Ozeki a first overseas success in the G1 2019 LONGINES Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin. Sakura Gospel, winner of the 2015 G2 Keio Hai Spring Cup, is another notable horses he has trained. Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 1.

**Size, John***CSP – Beauty Applause*

**Age:** 66. John Size was a top trainer in Sydney before his arrival in Hong Kong in 2001 with a reputation for improving and rekindling the spark in his horses. He broke the mould by winning the trainers' premiership in his very first season. Size's ninth championship in 2016/17 saw him set a new record for most winners in a season with 94, 27 more than nearest rival John Moore. In winning his 10th title in 2017/18, Size set a new benchmark for earnings in a season, accruing total prize money of HK\$176,441,240. His 11th title in 2018/19 was sealed after a tussle with rival John Moore that went to the season's final day. He has trained the winners of two Horse of the Year titles, the multiple HKG1 scorers Electronic Unicorn and Grand Delight. In 2009/10 he trained Brave Kid to equal the then record of six wins in a season and Entrapment who finally broke that record with seven victories in just five months. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Trainer (2001/02, 2002/03, 2003/04, 2005/06, 2007/08, 2009/10, 2011/12, 2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18, 2018/19); Australian Racing Hall of Fame inductee (2018). **FWD Champions Day race wins (7):** FWD QEII Cup (2004 River Dancer), FWD Champions Mile (2003 Electronic Unicorn, 2009 Sight Winner, 2017 Contentment), Chairman's Sprint Prize (2003 Grand Delight, 2018 Ivictory, 2019 Beat The Clock). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 1313.

**Sugiyama, Haruki***FWDQEII – Daring Tact*

**Age:** 39. Born in Kawasaki, Sugiyama joined the JRA as a groom in 2004. He obtained his JRA trainers' license in 2016 and notched his first major success as K T Brave took the JPN G1 JBC Classic in 2018. He enjoyed a monumental year in 2020 as Daring Tact, his current flagbearer, became the sixth in history, and the first ever unbeaten, Japanese Fillies' Triple Crown winner after sweeping the Oka Sho, Yushun Himba and Shuka Sho. Sugiyama has so far amassed 120 JRA wins, including eight (as at 11 April) this season. Hong Kong wins: Debut

**Ting, Jimmy K H***CSP – Amazing Star*

**Age:** 48. Jimmy Ting started out in 1988 as an apprentice jockey allocated to Brian Kan and became a fully-licensed rider in 1993. He retired from race-riding in 2003 and worked as assistant trainer to David Hill for two seasons, leaving to fulfil the same duties for Michael Chang with whom he worked for a further three years. Five years as assistant to Francis Lui preceded a five-year spell with Danny Shum. He was granted a full trainers' licence for the 2018/19 season and opened his account at the first attempt when Triumphant Jewel took the season opener at Sha Tin on 2 September, 2018. He accrued 38 wins that season. Ting added 35 wins in 2019/20, including four from Amazing Star, the Most Improved Horse of the season. Ting has gained overseas experience in Australia, Ireland and England. Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 95.

**Tsujino, Yasuyuki***FWDQEII – Kiseki*

**Age:** 39. Born in Osaka, Tsujino is part of a new crop of trainers having been licenced for the first time this year. He worked as a rider at a stud farm in Hokkaido before joining the JRA as a groom in 2005. Having worked in the Katsuhiko Sumii stable since 2006, Tsujino obtained his trainer licence in 2020 following Sumii's retirement, and commenced his stable operation at Ritto Training Centre in March, having inherited multiple horses including G1 Kikuka Sho winner Kiseki and JPN G1 Kashiwa Kinen winner Wide Pharaoh after Sumii's retirement. Tsujino notched his first win as a trainer with his second ever starter at Nakayama on 7 March, and has amassed 3 JRA wins to date (as at 1 April). Hong Kong wins: Debut



**Whyte, Douglas***CSP – Stronger*

**Age:** 49. Douglas Whyte's first season as a trainer in 2019/20 saw him accrue 44 wins. The former jockey was born in South Africa and earned the nickname "The Durban Demon" during his storied career in the saddle. He was Hong Kong's champion jockey for 13 consecutive seasons, establishing an incredible legacy. Whyte retired from the saddle in February 2019 with a Hong Kong record of 1,813 wins and all-time high prize money of more than HK\$1.5 billion. After a few months travelling to Europe, Dubai, South Africa and Australia to see how some of the world's master trainers ran their operations, Whyte commenced his own training career at Sha Tin's Olympic Stables on 15 July, 2019. An outstanding horseman, he first sat on a horse at age two and developed his skills riding in the countryside with his late father, himself a former jockey. A South African Jockey Academy graduate, in 1996 he rode weekends in Singapore and undertook a short contract in Hong Kong at the start of the 1996/97 season. He returned for the 1997/98 season and made Hong Kong his home. He was the first jockey to reach 1,000 wins in Hong Kong, and his tally of 114 wins in 2005/06 stood as a record until Joao Moreira surpassed it in 2014/15. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Jockey (13 consecutive seasons from 2000/01 to 2012/13); LONGINES IJC winner (2002, 2007, 2008); World Super Jockeys Series (Japan) winner (2004); six wins in a day as a jockey: 7 April, 2013 (a Hong Kong record-equalling feat at the time); record holder for overall career wins as a jockey in Hong Kong (1,813 wins) and most career prize money won by a jockey (over HK\$1.5 billion). Hong Kong wins as trainer (as of 11 April): 63

**Yahagi, Yoshito***FWDQEII – Loves Only You*

**Age:** 60. Yoshito Yahagi grew up at the vicinity of Oi Racecourse in Tokyo, as his father Kazuto is a former trainer and jockey in the regional NAR circuit. Yahagi travelled to Australia to learn the skills of training at Randwick, Flemington and Toowoomba, before coming back to Japan to start his career as a stable assistant in 1984. In 1990, he spent three months working with trainer Geoff Wragg in the UK. Yahagi received his JRA training licence in 2004 and has since become one of the top JRA trainers, having won the JRA Award four times, as the Best Trainer with most races won in 2014, 2016 and 2020. He has sent out 695 JRA winners (as of 1 April) including 16 this season which places him to an early lead in the 2021 JRA trainer's standings. Grand Prix Boss gave Yahagi the first of his 17 career G1/JPN G1 wins in the 2010 Asahi Hai Futurity Stakes. His other notable winners included Deep Brillante (2012 Tokyo Yushun), Real Steel (2016 Dubai Turf), Mozu Ascot (2018 Yasuda Kinen), 2020 Japanese Triple Crown winner Contrail, and 2019 G1 Cox Plate winner and JRA Horse of the Year Lys Gracieux. Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 0

**Yasuda, Takayuki***CSP – Danon Smash*

**Age:** 68. Born in Kyoto, Yasuda had 680 wins as a jockey between 1972 and 1994. In 1991, he rode a personal best 80 wins and partnered the legendary horse Tokai Teio to take two Japanese classics, the Satsuki Sho and Tokyo Yushun. Yasuda obtained his training licence in 1994 and registered his first victory in March 1995. Yasuda notched his first JRA Champion Trainer title with 62 wins in 2019. He has saddled 861 JRA career wins, including 14 this season (as of 1 April). Of the 18 G1/JPN G1 wins he has amassed so far, the great Lord Kanaloa remains the best horse he has ever trained. The Hall of Famer and 2013 Japanese Horse of the Year notched six G1 wins, including back-to-back successes in the G1 Sprinters Stakes and G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint in 2012 & 2013. Lord Kanaloa's son Danon Smash brought Yasuda a third G1 win in Hong Kong with success in the 2020 Hong Kong Sprint. Curren Chan (2011 Sprinters Stakes), Transcend (2010 & 2011 Japan Cup Dirt), Grape Brandy (2013 February Stakes), Danon The Kid (2020 Hopeful Stakes) and Fashionista (2020 JBC Ladies' Classic) are his other top performers. Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 3

**Yip, Dennis C H***CSP – Wishful Thinker*

**Age:** 53. HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School graduate Dennis Yip was licensed as a jockey in Hong Kong between 1984 and 1993. He rode a total of 59 winners before moving on to learn the training game overseas and then acting as assistant to multiple champion trainer, Brian Kan. In 2002/03 he became a licensed trainer in his own right. Yip trained more than 30 winners in each of his seasons as a trainer until he fell short with 26 wins in the 2019/20 season, despite a solid back half to the campaign following a slow start. The 2011/12 season saw him reach the 50-win mark as he finished fourth in the trainers' premiership. He maintained his upward curve in 2012/13 as he sent out 69 winners to clinch his first trainers' title, sealing victory over Tony Cruz in the very last race of the season. His biggest win that term came with Go Baby Go in the HKG3 Bauhinia Sprint Trophy, while All You Wish took Champion Griffin honours and the Most Improved Horse title. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Trainer (2012/13). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 768

**Yiu, Ricky P F***FWDCM – Mighty Giant; CSP – Jolly Banner, Voyage Warrior*

**Age:** 63. Ricky Yiu rode 11 winners between 1974 and 1980 when apprenticed to Jack Goswell, and was first licensed as a trainer in 1995/96, after learning the ropes as assistant trainer to Gordon Smyth and Eddie Lo. He achieved a lifelong ambition in 2019/20 when he was crowned champion trainer, having unexpectedly led his rivals for most of the campaign; his final tally of 67 wins meant that he held off second-placed Tony Cruz by two. One of his greatest early moments came with Fairy King Prawn's success in the inaugural Hong Kong Sprint of 1999. Three-time world champion sprinter Sacred Kingdom, one of Hong Kong's all-time greats, was his outstanding stable star and the two-time G1 Hong Kong Sprint winner and 2009/10 Horse of the Year won the Hong Kong Champion Sprinter title for the fourth year in succession in 2010/11. In 2010 he also sent out Ultra Fantasy to triumph in the G1 Sprinters Stakes at Nakayama as, with Alex Lai on board, the pair became the first Hong Kong Chinese trainer-jockey partnership to triumph in an overseas G1 event. Following Sacred Kingdom's retirement in the spring of 2012, another blistering speedster, Amber Sky, provided Yiu with further elite success at home and abroad. His son, Eric Yiu, was appointed the stable's assistant trainer ahead of the 2018/19 season. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Trainer (2019/20). **FWD Champions Day race wins (3):** Chairman's Sprint Prize (1999 Fairy King Prawn, 2008 and 2010 Sacred Kingdom). Hong Kong wins (as of 11 April): 838

### Badel, Alexis

**Age:** 31. Alexis Badel hails from a racing tradition, his mother being trainer Myriam Bollack-Badel and his father, former jockey Alain Badel. He was France's Champion Apprentice in 2007 and broke into the top 10 in the premierships in just his second year riding with 60 winners. Badel's first Group race win came aboard Norse King in the October, 2013 Prix du Conseil de Paris. He was appointed as the second retained rider for The Aga Khan behind Christophe Soumillon at the beginning of the 2015 racing season and went on to record his most successful season to date with 104 wins. That saw him obtain seventh position in the French Championship. He debuted at Sha Tin with two mounts on 11 December, 2016. His first Hong Kong winner was Supreme Profit on 27 December, 2016 and he ended that maiden two-month stint with seven wins. He returned in the 2017/18 season, landing 14 wins. Following his second campaign in Hong Kong, Badel returned for a third short-term stint and landed 26 wins in under four months - his best haul to date. Badel returns on a full-season licence for the 2020/21 season. He secured a first G1 win aboard Nonza in the August, 2018 Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville. **Honours:** France's Champion Apprentice (2007). **Hong Kong wins:** 103 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Borges, Vagner

**Age:** 28. Vagner Borges is one of South American horse racing's brightest stars. A four-time champion jockey in his native Brazil, he partnered that country's 12th Triple Crown winner, Bal A Bali, to his famous classic successes in the 2014 season. Borges was a phenomenon as an apprentice upon commencing his career in the 2009/10 season at Gavea Racecourse in Rio de Janeiro. In December 2011 he collected his 374th success to set a new Brazilian record for the most wins by an apprentice, two months before he graduated to the fully-licensed ranks. He took his first jockeys' championship in 2011/12 with a career-high 244 wins at a win strike rate of 20.75%. Borges maintained a win strike rate above 20% in each of his further three championship seasons, notching 212, 218 wins and 186 wins. He has accrued no less than 14 career G1 wins, his first being Sutil in the March 2013 Grande Premio Diana. The lightweight rider has more than 1600 career wins on the board and, he scored his first Hong Kong Pattern race victory aboard Amazing Star in the G2 Sprint Cup. **Honours:** Four-time champion jockey in Brazil (2011/12, 2013/14, 2014/15, 2017/18); Brazil's champion apprentice. **Hong Kong wins:** 35 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Chadwick, Matthew

**Age:** 30. A graduate of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Apprentice Jockeys' School, Matthew Chadwick went to Australia for his apprentice training and rode a four-timer at Lismore Racecourse at age 17. Indentured to the Tony Cruz stable upon his return to Hong Kong, he was champion apprentice in 2008/09. He earned a full jockey's licence in January, 2010. His first Group race winner was Egyptian Ra in the HKG3 National Day Cup (2009). He is most famous for his partnership with California Memory and became the first homegrown rider to win a Hong Kong International Races contest when clinching the G1 Hong Kong Cup on the grey in December, 2011. Chadwick notched his 250th win in Hong Kong with Majestic Anthem on 26 December, 2013 and rode his first Hong Kong four-timer at Sha Tin on 22 June, 2014. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Apprentice (2008/09); Shergar Cup Silver Saddle winner (2012). **Hong Kong wins:** 398 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Hamelin, Antoine

**Age:** 29. Frenchman Antoine Hamelin began his career as an apprentice to Jean de Roualle in Chantilly and has since ridden more than 700 winners. His first win came for Alain de Royer-Dupre aboard the Aga Khan-owned Artana at Lyon-Parilly racecourse on 11 November, 2009. Hamelin completed his apprenticeship under the tutelage of Royer-Dupre and went freelance upon earning fully-fledged jockey status, basing himself out of Chantilly. He is best known for his association with Saonois, who he partnered to classic victory in the 2012 G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly among other wins. Hamelin first rode in Hong Kong when pairing with Saonois to finish 10th in the 2012 LONGINES Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin. Hamelin kicked off his three month contract with a first-day double at Sha Tin, firstly aboard Best For You before Baltic Success burst clear later that day. Hamelin secured 17 wins across his first stint in Hong Kong and returns on a full-season licence for 2020/21. Hamelin has ridden in Great Britain, Ireland, Italy, Germany, USA, Spain, Dubai and Canada. In 2017 he gained a first Royal Ascot success in the Albany Stakes aboard 20/1 shot Different League. **Hong Kong wins:** 37 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Ho, Vincent C Y

**Age:** 30. HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School graduate Vincent Ho racked up 44 wins as a young rider in New Zealand under the tutelage of leading trainer Lance O'Sullivan. He made a good start to his Hong Kong career with 10 victories in his first season in 2009/10, including a trio of wins he achieved on only his fourth race day in Hong Kong. He sealed the 2010/11 Champion Apprentice title with 39 wins. Ho reached the graduation benchmark on 1 October, 2012 by claiming his 70th win in Hong Kong on board Castle Hero. He notched 33 wins in 2014/15 to be the season's leading homegrown rider. Ho enjoyed his best season to date in 2019/20 with not only a career-high 67 wins but a renewed partnership with the brilliant Golden Sixty saw the pair sweep the Four-Year-Old Classic Series, while also unbeaten in seven runs that term, which culminated in a thrilling Hong Kong Derby victory. Ho followed those triumphs with a career-first G1, saluting with Southern Legend in 2020 Champions Mile, outlasting Beauty Generation by a short-head in the process. So far this season, he has added a further three G1s to his haul aboard Golden Sixty. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Apprentice (2010/11); Best Freelance Jockey Award (2014/15); Tony Cruz Award (2018/19 & 2019/20). **FWD Champions Day wins (1):** FWD Champions Mile (2020 Southern Legend). **Hong Kong wins:** 378 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Leung, Derek K C

**Age:** 32. A product of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Apprentice Jockeys' School, Derek Leung cut his teeth as a young rider in New Zealand under the tutelage of trainer Lance O'Sullivan. He was assigned as apprentice jockey to Paul O'Sullivan's stable upon his return to Hong Kong and reached the graduation benchmark after claiming his 70th win aboard Star Of Fame on 1 June, 2011. Leung reached a personal best total of 37 wins in the 2017/18 season, enough to earn a second consecutive Tony Cruz Award as the leading home-grown rider. That season also saw Leung notch a first career Group 1 aboard subsequent Horse of the Year Beauty Generation. The rider was also in the plate for Group 3 and Group 2 wins on the gelding. **Honours:** Asian Young Guns Challenge winner (2010); Tony Cruz Award winner (2017 & 2018). **Hong Kong wins:** 343 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Maia, Ruan

**Age:** 32. Ruan Maia began his riding career in 2006 as an apprentice in Sao Paulo, Brazil. Maia was a leading jockey in his home country before setting his sights on an international career and in 2016 he made the move to Macau. Maia was crowned champion jockey in both of his only two full seasons he completed in Macau, finishing with 60 and 71 wins respectively, he also scored two major victories at MAC G1 level, claiming the Macau Gold Cup and Chairman's Challenge Cup. In April 2018, Maia made his first visit to Singapore and tasted instant success aboard former Hong Kong-based galloper Circuit Land in the SIN G2 Chairman's Trophy at Kranji Racecourse. In May that same year he rode for the first time in Hong Kong at the 2018 Hong Kong Macau Trophy race day, and his best result from six rides on the card was a second atop the Tony Cruz-trained California Joy. At the start of 2020, Maia took the opportunity to shift base to Singapore and in his first full season he finished second in the Singapore jockeys' championship to now four-time champion Vlad Duric by three wins, ending his first and only campaign in the Lion City with 62 wins at a win strike rate of 17.7%. **Honours:** Macau Champion Jockey (2017/18, 2018/19). **Hong Kong wins:** 4 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Matsuyama, Kohei

**Age:** 31. Born in Kobe, Japan, Matsuyama developed an interest in racing as he regularly attended races with his father and grandfather at Hanshin Racecourse. In 2006, he enrolled to the JRA Riding School jockey training programme and started riding in races in March, 2009, where he scored two wins at his riding debut at Kokura Racecourse. He was crowned the JRA Champion Rookie with 36 wins in that same year. Matsuyama notched his first Pattern win with Smart Gear in the G3 Chunichi Shimbun Hai in 2012, his first top-class success with Corin Berry in the 2015 JPN G1 JBC Sprint, and his first Classic win aboard Ai Ain in the 2017 G1 Satsuki Sho. Matsuyama reached new heights in his career in 2020 as he partnered Daring Tact to become the sixth ever, and the first to do so unbeaten, Fillies' Triple Crown winner in Japan. He has so far amassed 806 JRA wins and currently sits second behind Christophe Lemaire in this year's JRA Jockey's Championship. **Hong Kong wins:** Debut



### Moreira, Joao

**Age:** 37. Brazilian sensation Joao Moreira, known as "Magic Man", notched more than 1,000 wins in South America. He relocated to Singapore in 2009 and was a dominant four-time champion jockey. He moved to Hong Kong in October 2013 and was runner-up in the title race that term with 97 wins before clinching a first championship in a record smashing 2014/15 campaign that yielded an all-time high 145 wins - he demolished that record in 2015/16 with 168 wins, and improved again in 2016/17 with 170 wins. In December, 2020, Moreira notched his 1000th Hong Kong win. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Jockey (2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17); LONGINES IJC winner (2012); Japan's World All-Star Jockeys winner (2015); Singapore Champion Jockey (2010, 2011, 2012, 2013); Brazilian Eclipse Award winner (2006/07, 2007/08); fastest 100 in a Hong Kong season (22 February, 2017); Hong Kong record for most wins in a season (170 in 2016/17); most wins in a Hong Kong race day (eight: 5 March, 2017); Singapore record for most wins in a season (206 in 2012); eight wins from eight rides at Kranji (6 September, 2013); eight wins in a day at Cidade Jardim (March, 2006). **FWD Champions Day wins (4):** FWD QEII Cup (2017 Neorealism), FWD Champions Mile (2015 Able Friend, 2016 Maurice), Chairman's Sprint Prize (2019 Beat The Clock). **Hong Kong wins:** 1055 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Piccone, Tony

**Age:** 33. Tony Piccone was inspired to become a jockey when, as a child, he would watch his jockey father, Jean-Marc Piccone, competing in races. His own career began at age 14 when he was accepted to the apprentice jockeys' school in Marseille. At age 17 he was apprenticed to Chantilly trainer Cedric Boutin and rode out his claim in 2008. He has since made his name as a prominent freelance jockey and has accrued no less than 760 wins including five at Group 1 level. His initial Group 1 victory was aboard Robin Of Navan in the 2015 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. Piccone secured his first Hong Kong win with his fourth ride at his first race meeting, driving home Charity Go at Sha Tin on Wednesday, 1 January, 2020. He closed out his first term in Hong Kong with eight wins, including two doubles. **Hong Kong wins:** 14 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Poon, Matthew M F

**Age:** 27. Matthew Poon joined Hong Kong's race-riding ranks in March 2017. He landed a win on his first race-day but also suffered an injury that side-lined him for three weeks. Upon returning he raced to 20 wins and a reduction to his 10lb claim within 14 fixtures and 112 rides. His second Hong Kong season yielded 35 victories. The HKJC Apprentice Jockeys' School student undertook his overseas training in South Australia, embarking in June 2015, and was based with leading trainer Richard Jolly. His first race ride, a winner, came in October of that year. At the end of his first season, in July, 2016, he was crowned South Australia's Champion Apprentice Jockey with 51 wins. His second season in Adelaide saw him ride 65 winners and at the time of his departure for Hong Kong in March 2017, he was sitting second in the South Australian jockeys championship. Poon commenced his Hong Kong career with an overall record of 117 wins from 862 rides at a rate of 13.57%. His first pattern victory came aboard Faaltless in the SIN G3 Garden City Trophy in Singapore in August, 2017 and he notched a second win in that grade when taking the Jumbo Jet Trophy at Kranji during the Hong Kong off-season in 2018. **Honours:** South Australia Champion Apprentice (2015/16). **Hong Kong wins:** 146 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Purton, Zac

**Age:** 38. Zac Purton ended Douglas Whyte's 13-season dominance with his first Hong Kong jockeys' championship in 2013/14 (112 wins) and in earning his second title in 2017/18 he halted Joao Moreira's title streak at three. During his first championship season, the Australian ace raced to what was then the fastest 50 in Hong Kong history and became the second rider, after Whyte, to notch 100 wins in a season. Purton lost his title when second to Moreira in 2014/15 with 95 wins, a position he filled for the next two terms, including when notching his second century in 2016/17. His second championship was a remarkable effort as he chased down Moreira to take the lead for the first time that term on June 10, 2018. Five weeks later, at season's end, he had outpointed Moreira 136-134 with a win strike rate of 21% to the Brazilian's 20%. Purton tallied a career-high 168 wins in 2018/19, a season in which he also became the second jockey in Hong Kong history to ride 1000 winners, and in which he set a new single season prizemoney record of HK\$234,989,515. The Australian ace took a third consecutive championship in 2019/20 with 147 wins and three Group 1's, his triumph aboard Exultant in the 2020 QEII Cup meant he became the only rider in history to have won every Group 1 race on the Hong Kong calendar. **Honours:** Hong Kong Champion Jockey (2013/14, 2017/18, 2018/19 & 2019/20); Brisbane Champion Jockey (2003 - when still an apprentice); LONGINES IJC winner (2017); World Super Jockeys Series (Japan) winner (2012); Hong Kong single season prize money record (HK\$234,989,515). **FWD Champions Day wins (4):** FWD QEII Cup (2020 Exultant), Chairman's Sprint Prize (2018 Ivictory), FWD Champions Mile (2018 & 2019 Beauty Generation) **Hong Kong wins:** 1262 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Schofield, Chad

**Age:** 27. Chad Schofield spent four years (2002-2006) of his youth living in Hong Kong where his father, the South African jockey Glyn Schofield, was contracted to ride. His family relocated to Australia and Schofield commenced his own riding career in Sydney in the 2010/11 season, enjoying rapid success. He moved to Melbourne in 2012 to ride for the powerful David Hayes stable. His first Group 1 win was a major, the 2013 Cox Plate on Shamus Award. He and his father made history in 2014 as the first father and son to compete against each other in the Melbourne Cup and at Sha Tin on 14 February, 2016 they became the first in Hong Kong to ride against each other. Schofield tallied 43 wins during the 2019/20 season, five more than his previous best. Schofield spent three months during the summer of 2015 riding in England, based out of Ed Dunlop's yard, and scored two wins from 42 rides. **Honours:** Sydney and New South Wales Champion Apprentice (2011/12); Melbourne Champion Apprentice (2012/13). **Hong Kong wins:** 197 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Shinn, Blake

**Age:** 33. Blake Shinn's father is the late Gerald Shinn, a one-time champion apprentice jockey in Australia. He began his career in Victoria and his first win came at Kilmore in 2003 aboard Clearly Unique. He showed brilliant precocity, winning his first G1, the 2005 Adelaide Cup aboard Demerger, at just 17 years of age when still an apprentice. He made history in the 2004/05 season, becoming the first apprentice to win the Scobie Breasley Medal for excellence in race riding on the Melbourne circuit. Shinn made the move to Sydney to become stable jockey to Gai Waterhouse and in his first year he won the 2007/08 Sydney premiership. He also has the distinction of being one of the youngest Melbourne Cup-winning jockeys, being just 20 when he partnered the Bart Cummings-trained Viewed in 2008. He finished runner-up in the 2017/18 Sydney Jockeys' premiership with 136 wins. **Honours:** Sydney Jockeys' Premiership (2007/08); Victorian champion apprentice (2005/06); Scobie Breasley Medal (2005); Nathan Berry Medal (2018). **Hong Kong wins:** 30 (as of 11 April, 2021).



### Teetan, Karis

**Age:** 30. Mauritian rider Karis Teetan was well ensconced in the top 10 of the South African Jockeys' Championship when he left for Hong Kong in August, 2013. He entered the South African Jockey Academy at the age of 14 and went on to be crowned South African Champion Apprentice in 2008. He graduated in 2009 with 147 wins to his credit. Teetan passed the 100-win mark in every season as a senior jockey in South Africa. His first top level win was in his native Mauritius on 24 November, 2008, aboard Halo Hunter. Teetan represented South Africa in the 2012 International Jockeys' Invitational in Seoul, Korea and in the 2008 Macau Apprentice Jockeys Invitation Races. He notched an impressive 50 wins in his first Hong Kong season and has continued to build on that good start. He finished third in the 2017/18 premiership race with 52 wins, which included a trio of Group 3 triumphs. - At the end of a race meeting, the jockey with the highest accumulated Jockey Challenge Points will be declared as the winner. The Jockey Challenge Points for all jockeys (including jockeys in No. 14) will be counted on an individual basis.
- The “countback” rule will be used as a tie-breaker should two or more jockeys collect the same number of Jockey Challenge Points on their Scheduled Rides.
