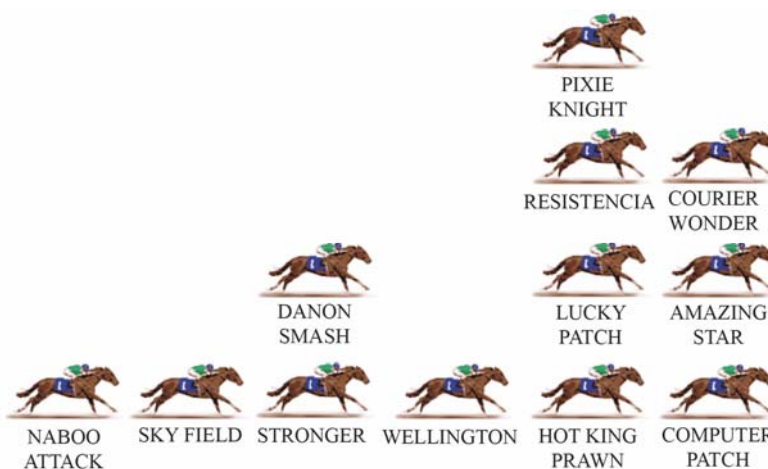

The Sprint is a race that suits a horse that is close to the pace. This year's contest looks like there will be plenty of horses trying to either lead or sit just in behind the leader. Barrier draws are crucial as there is only a short run to the first turn and horses can easily be trapped wide, limiting their chance of success. Last year the winner came from the rear, so it is possible although history suggests being on the pace is an advantage.
