With a long run to the first bend barrier draws are not so important in the mile contest. Horses have every opportunity to get themselves into their normal running positions which will give every horse plenty of opportunity to gain success. History of the race suggests that the winners can come from anywhere in the field. The pace does not look strong this year so should be run at an even to slow tempo.
