| <b>Main facilities</b>                         | New indoor sand arena                  | 47-meter x 22-metre arena with translucent skylight, LED lights and 3 state-of-the-art fans, ensuring riders and horses can continue training regardless of weather conditions             |
|  | Expanded and upgraded stables          | Increase from 33 to 38 horse stalls with rubber flooring, automatic water drinkers, air conditioning systems, horse weighing scale and sophisticated farrier workshop to aid horse welfare |
|  | New equine simulators                  | 2 equine simulators for training and skill development   |
|  | New classrooms                         | 2 rooms with 30 seats and interactive touchscreen smart TV for lectures and workshops  |
|  | New viewing gallery                    | 5 seats for the differently abled together with seats for their companions, and an elevated seating area for 16 visitors   |
| <b>Barrier free and sustainable facilities</b> | Barrier free facilities                | Automatic doors, assistive listening system, passenger lift, tactile guide path for the visually-impaired and accessible toilets with nappy changing table                                 |
|  | Sustainable design                     | Photovoltaic system, semi-translucent roof for natural lighting, sustainably sourced building materials  |
| <b>Programmes and services</b>                 | Lessons                                | Operating schedules expanded from 6 days to 7 days per week, with an expected weekly capacity of 65 hours (14% increase in capacity)   |
|  | Short-term package course              | New short-term courses including riding lessons, simulator training and stable management  |
|  | Stable visits                          | Group stable visits (maximum capacity: 20 people): 10 per week, effective from November 2025   |
|  | Special programmes                     | Special riding programmes for primary and secondary school students during Christmas, Easter and Summer holidays   |
|  | International certificated course      | Training and assessments for Hong Kong Pony Club and British Horse Society qualifications  |
